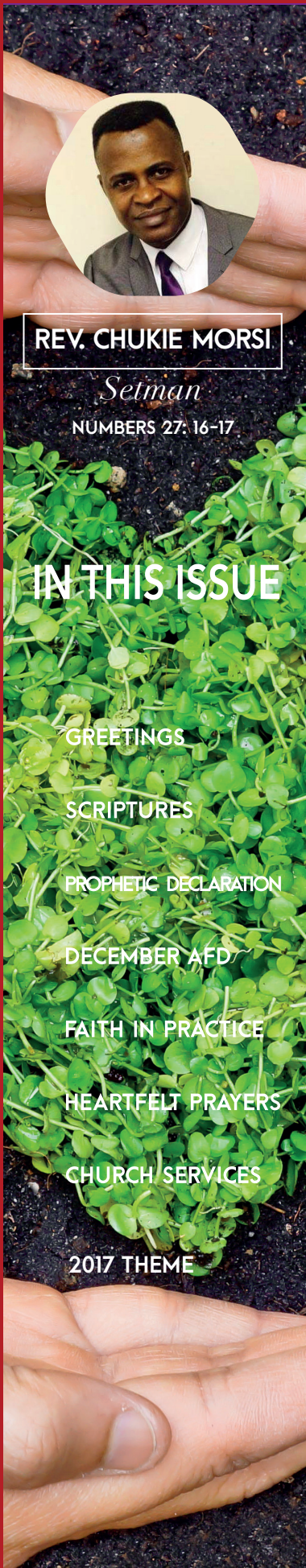

“ . . . but as his part is that goeth down to the battle, so shall his part be that tarrieth by the stuff: they shall part alike.”

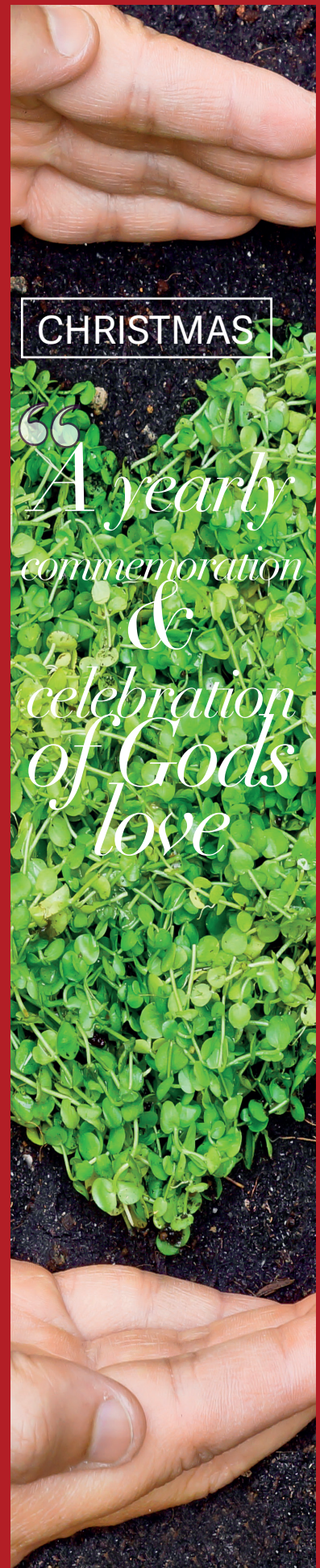
The scripture above indicates that we share the

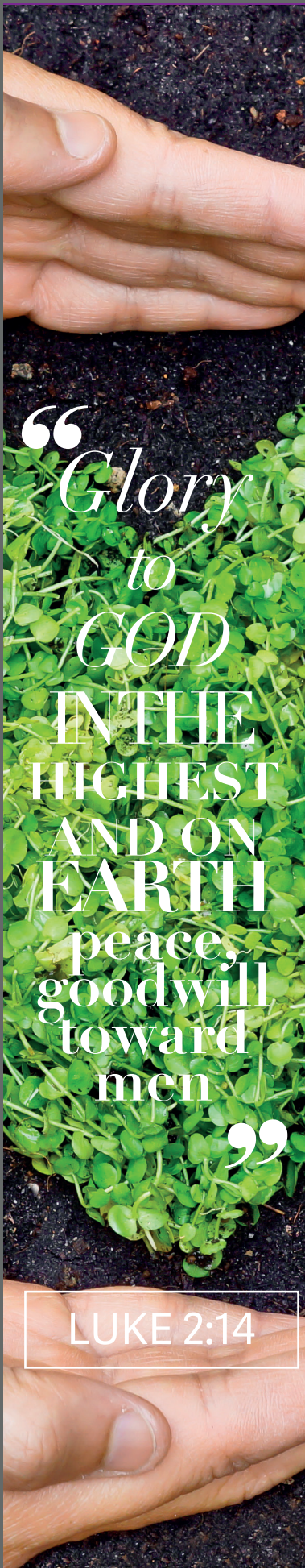

Emmanuel: God Dwelling With Humanity!

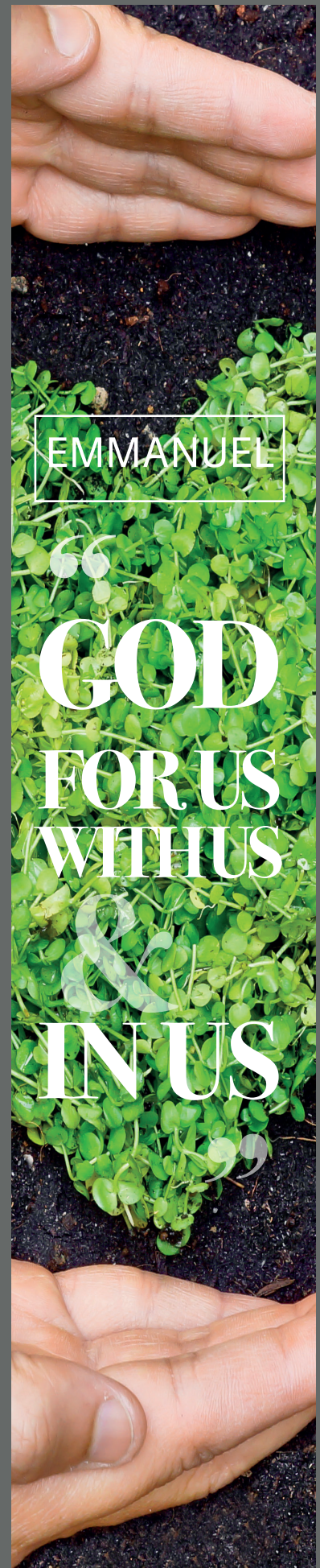

Romans 8: ¹⁰And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. ¹¹ But if



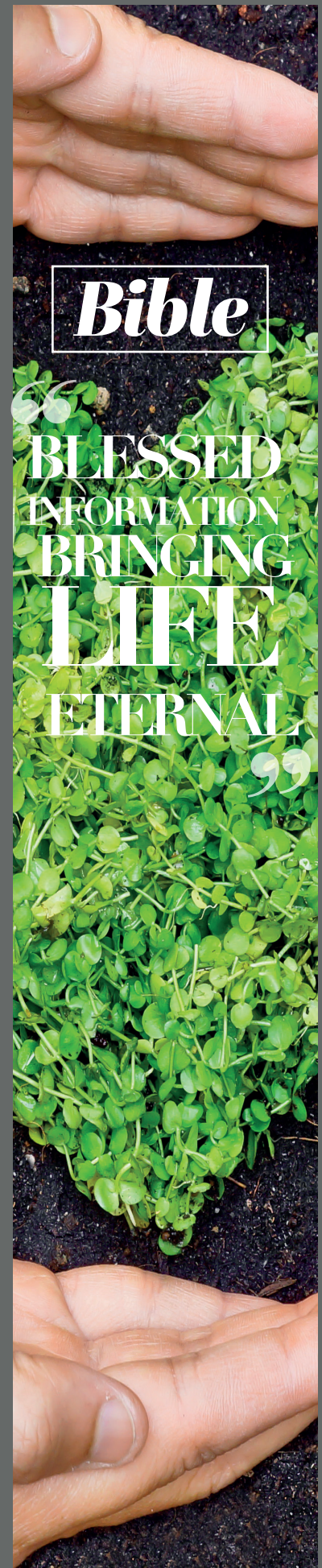

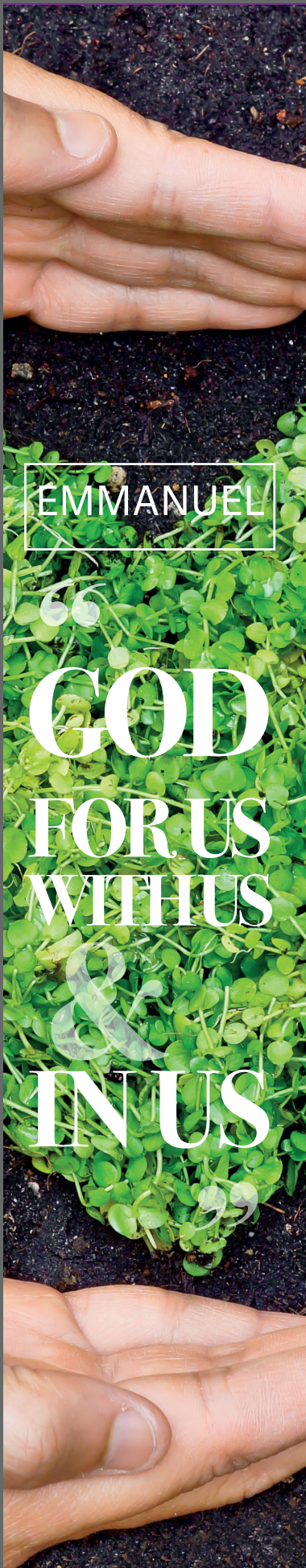
This Day & This Christmas: Fear Not! Worry Not!

“And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. ¹¹ For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. ¹² And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men”. Luke 2:10-14

When one is going through confused and frightening life experiences, and at dead ends in life's pursuit, hearing the words 'FEAR NOT' (as in Luke 2:10-14) should be profound, inspiring, revealing as well as empowering. I mean life matters and experiences that seem to defy your knowledge and understanding of economics, medical issues, technology, and academics, marital and relationship acumen.

The phrase '*fear not*' is used over 366 in the BIBLE, which is my "Blessed Information Bringing Life Eternal" At least

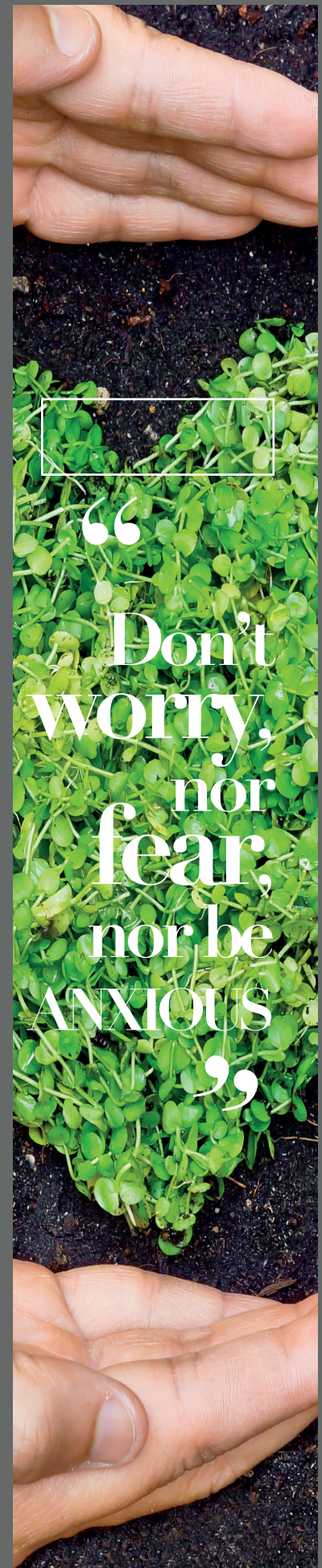
shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear, but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind

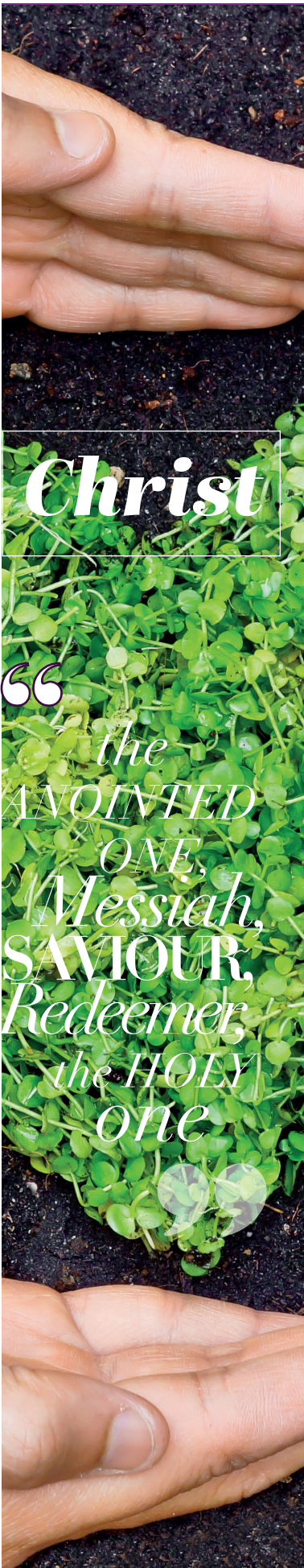
Fear is the enemy's policing officer to those whose hearts faint, go weary, are not steady and have no confidence in the authenticity of God's Word. Faith in God is the antidote to fear. Faith in God's Word is faith in God and God will answer us when we call upon His name. So, have FAITH in God - Mark 11:22-24.

The fear of what to eat, drink and to be clothed in this Christmas and afterwards can cause worries and anxiety. If not kept in check it can cause high blood pressure and other various vices and malady. Jesus warns us of the dangers that worry or anxiety and fear cause in Matthew 6:25-34 (Also in Luke 12:22-34).

Matthew 6:25-34 . . . 'Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? ²⁶ Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? ²⁷ Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? ²⁸ And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: ²⁹ and yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. ³⁰ Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? ³¹ Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? ³² (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. ³³ But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. ³⁴ Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

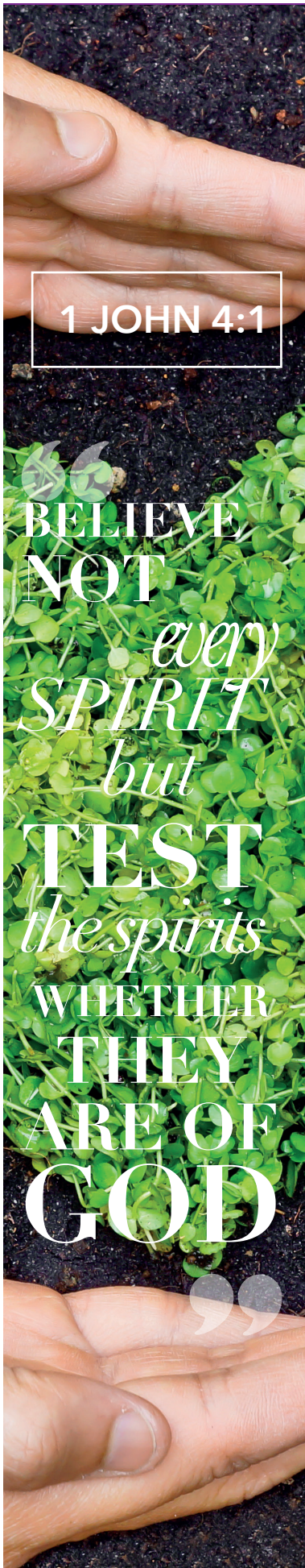

It's imperative to commemorate and celebrate His birth. In being objective, I have sectioned the word Christmas in this way. That is, CHRIST and MAS. Wherefore, Christ means, the anointed One, the Messiah, the Saviour, the Holy one of Israel and the Redeemer. And 'MAS' or MASS To Celebrate, commemorate, Observe.

CHRISTMAS in this context is the yearly commemoration and Celebration of God's love in the birth of Christ and His cause on Earth. Hence, signifying the sharing of that grace and the benediction of the triune God expressed through their love to mankind as in 2 Corinthians 13:14 'The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit, be with you all. Amen'

Some have replaced the 'Christ' of Christmas with an X for Xmas. Probably because they are ignorant or they can't comprehend and imagine the good that Christ brings into Christmas, hence they chose the use of the negative connotations that X represents. You see it in advert through the media, Christmas cards and such like





to undermine the true essence for which Christ was born and named in Christmas. Christ is not the same as X. It is not a worthwhile abbreviation either.

However there are other opinions about Christmas, while some say Christmas is not important and is not worth any form of commemoration and celebration because it's a heathen day, a pagan holiday. Others indicate that December 25th is not the day on which Christ was born but in October. These people also say that He was born spiritual and not with physical nature. According to some it is for pagans and Satanists due to the glamorous events and activities that are now associated to this date especially with the financial indiscipline and indebtedness people entangle themselves into as a result of the celebration and commemoration in quote.



Just because the enemy perverts and distorts the meaning and essence of the celebration of Christmas, does not mean that we should let go of that which we believe is of God - that is, Christ was born for us all according to the scriptures.

For me and every supposed Spirit born child of God, what is vital in the whole scenario of indifference is that Christ was born in the flesh - humanity. This is without

controversy as endorsed in 1 Timothy 3:16. Dates and times should not be an issue, but the act of acknowledging this very fact and truth of God in the light of the Holy Scriptures makes the journey of the Christian FAITH meaningful to anyone that believes in Christ Jesus as saviour and Lord.

1 John 4:1-6 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. 2 Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: 3 and every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world. 4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. 5 They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them. 6 We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

Philemon 6 That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.

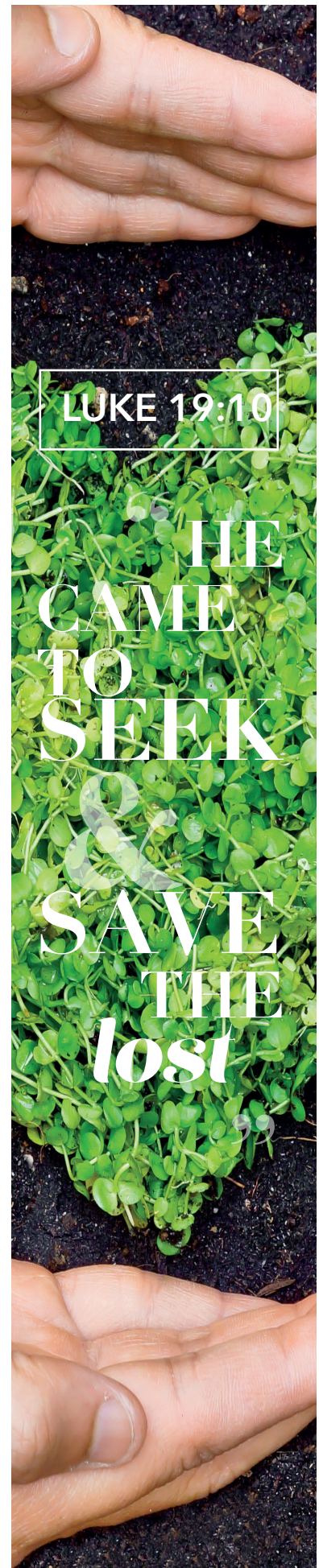

privilege to partake in not only in this season but as a daily experience in their act of doing and living life.

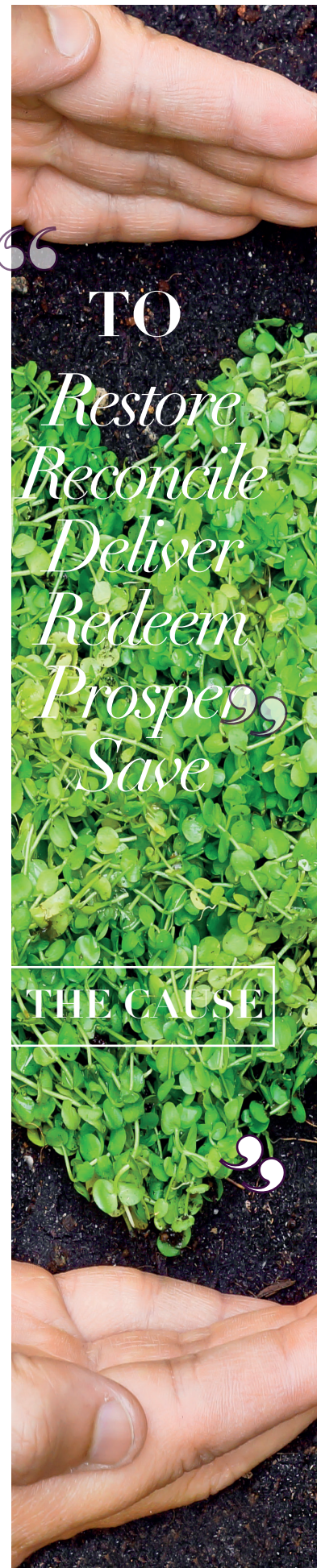

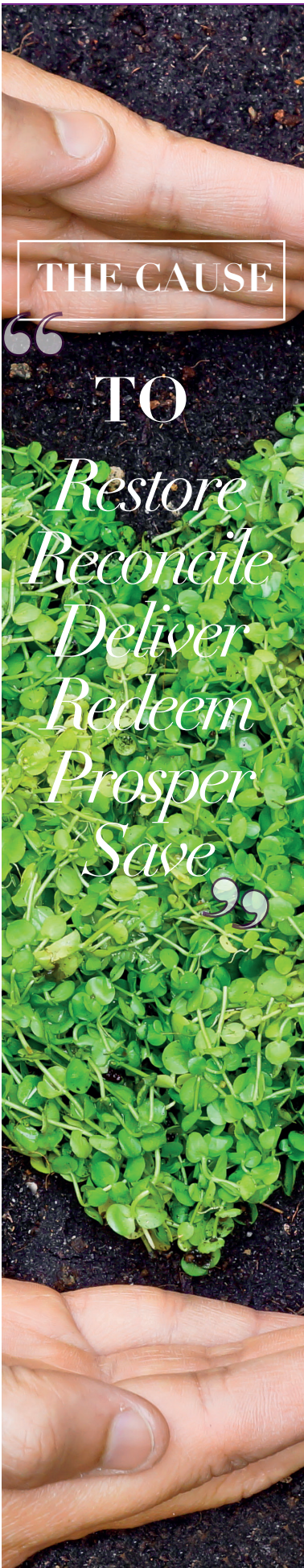

The Holy writ indicates that Christ was born for a Cause including these undermentioned causes:

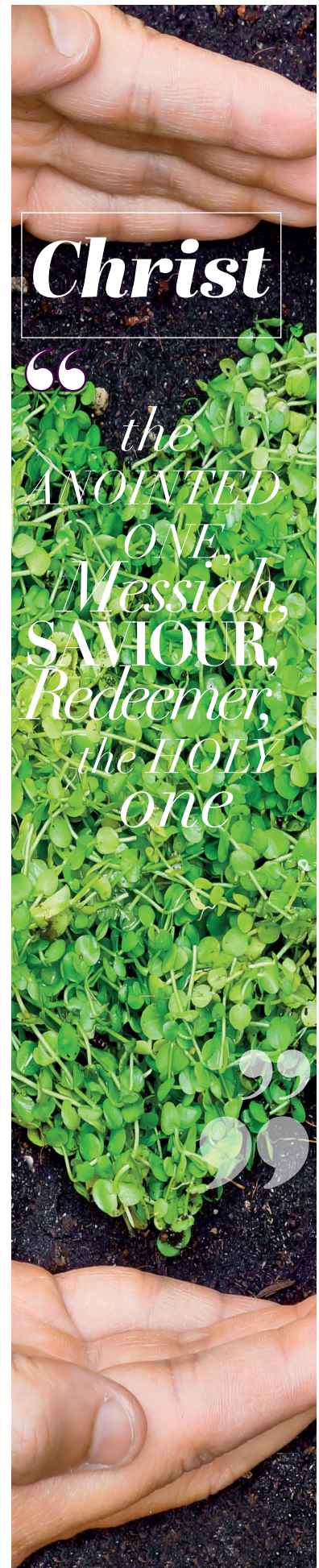
- To give man a purpose for life and fulfilment (John 3:16-17; John 10:10; 1 John 3:8; John 18:37)

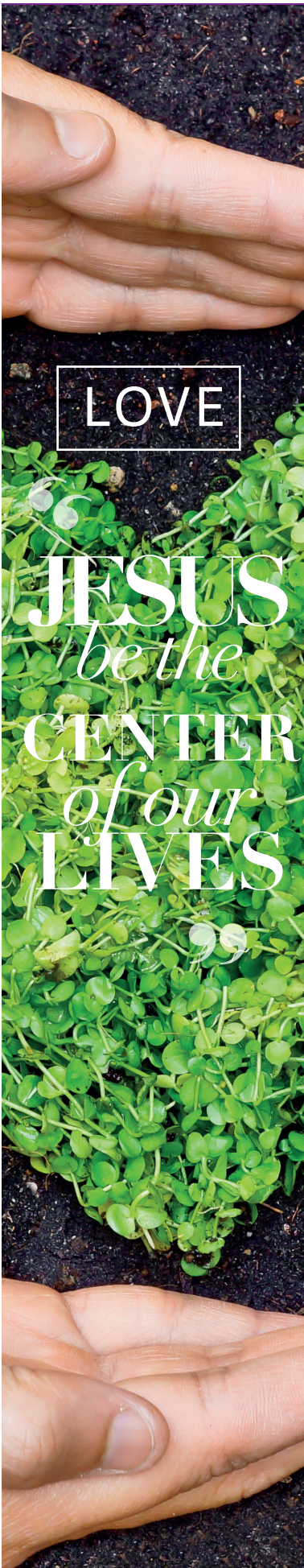
COMMEMORATING LOVE - GOD'S GIFT OF LIFE

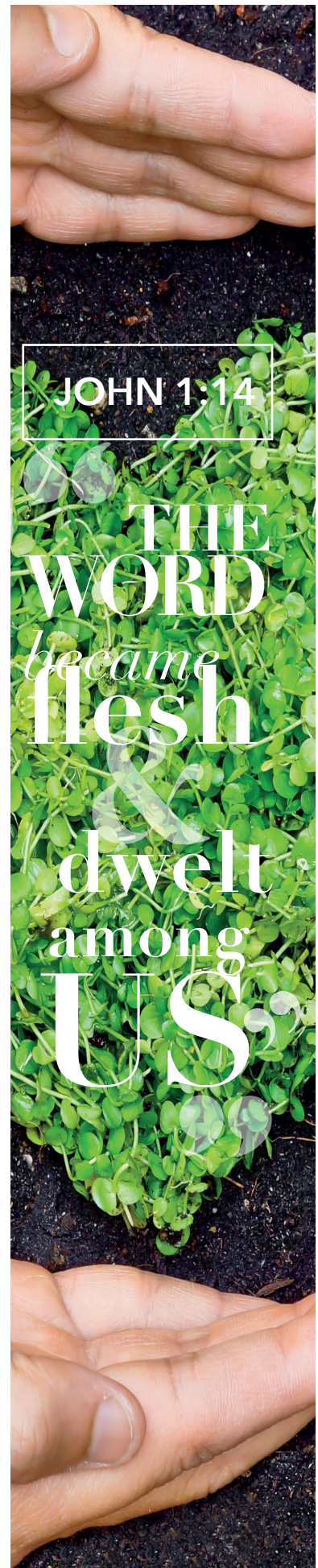

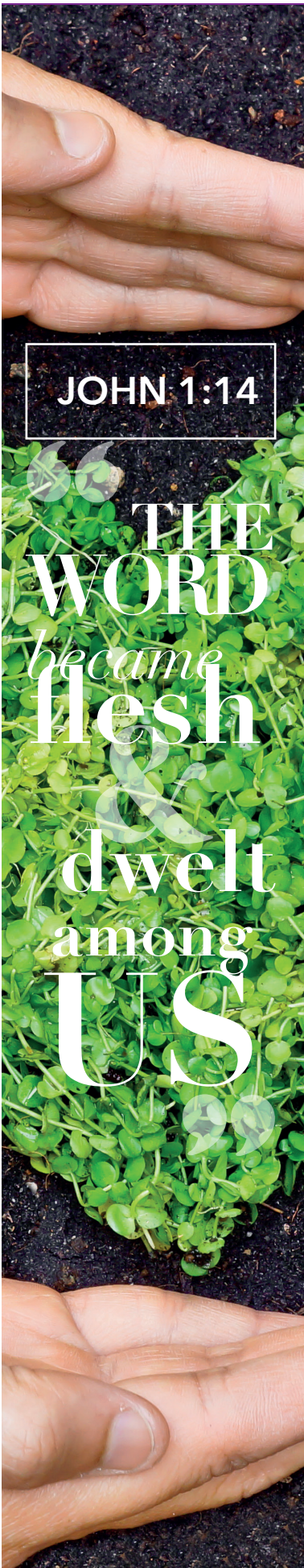

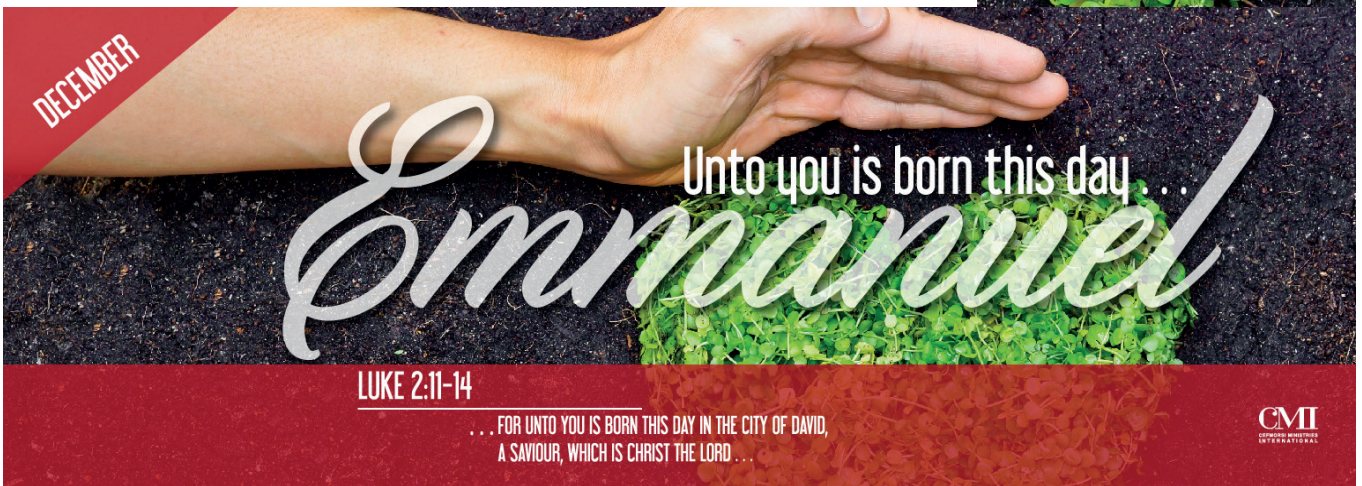

know the word for yourself

Sometime ago I signed up for a Bible devotional with an on-line Bible. On one of the evenings I just thought to share out loud this devotional with my husband. As I got to a part about Jonah that linked him to 2 Kings and King Jeroboam, - saying the book of 2nd Kings tells of Jonah's ministry under Jeroboam II, king of Israel.'

My husband says "Wait a minute, that's not right. The story in 2 Kings 14 only refers to Jonah's ministry in verse 25 - what you just read doesn't sound completely right of Jonah's ministry."

Now I don't know this. I don't know where in the scripture the story of Jonah is other than in the book of Jonah. So I had to log right on to 2nd Kings and read it for myself. Set the record straight in my own mind. Just because it sounds right; just because it's coming from a reputable man of God does not mean that it's the word of God.

This for me re-enforces the truth that we need to know the word for ourselves. Don't be satisfied with what you hear on the pulpit alone. Just like the Beria Christians did in Acts 17:10-12

"And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews. 11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. 12 Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few . After you listen to these teachings and or teachings - go and search the scripture.

Paul says in 1 Corinthians 13:9-10

"For we know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away". (NKJV)

The Word of God needs to come alive in you as you read and study, it is the revealed Word of God, that is how it works. You may read the same passage again some time later in your life and what that speaks to you differs from what it may originally have meant for you. Apply the Word in everything and in anything that you do as a child of God. Yet when we don't know what it is that the word of God says about something, how then will we know how to be.

Faith pleases God. Faith is acting on the Word of God. It is acting on what you believe. You will need to know what you believe in order to act on it.

Study the Word.

Know God. Fellowship with Him.

Enhance your relationship with God.

Don't be deceived by teaching that may sound right.

With the Holy Spirit living in you, He is able to guide you and bare witness to the things that you ought to do and not to do.

The more time that you spend in His presence, the more you know Him and know His voice without a doubt.

2 Timothy 2:15 "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

2 Timothy 3:14-17 "But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; 15 and that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 that the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works."

You shall not neglect your Church - Hebrews 10:25, 2 Corinthians 13:14

Finally: Selfishness makes Christmas a burden but love makes Christmas peace, love and joy.


