*Galatians 5:6 “For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth anything, nor uncircumcision; but Faith which worketh by Love.”*

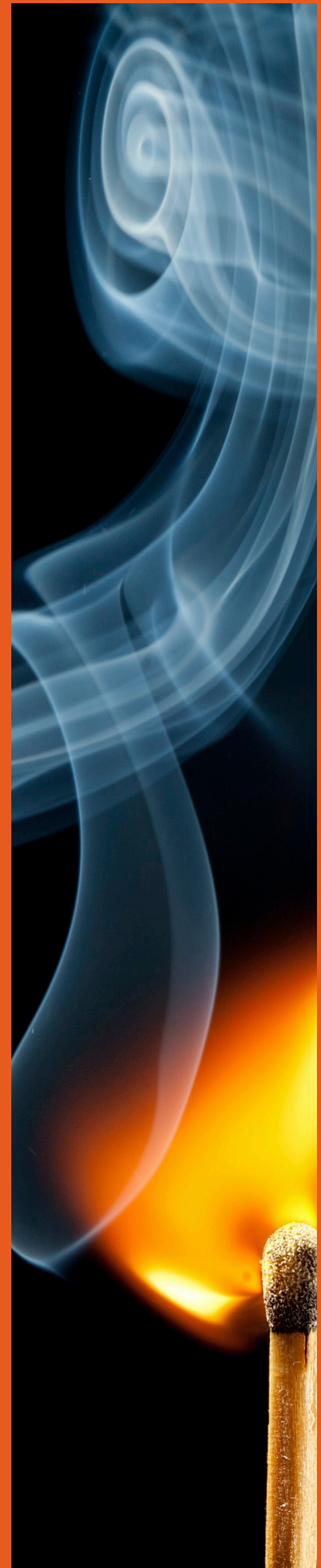

*Galatians 5:6 "For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but Faith which worketh by Love"*

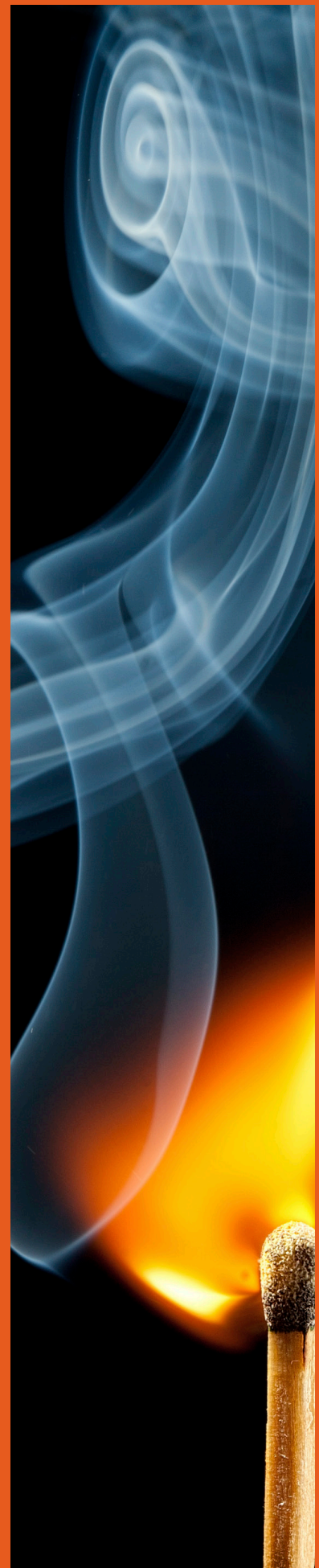

### Prophetic Declaration:

*James 2:14-26 “What doth it profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath faith, and have not works? can faith save him? 15 If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food, 16 and one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit? 17 Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. 18 Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. 19 Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. 20 But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? 21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? 22 Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? 23 And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. 24 Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only. 25 Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent*





*them out another way? 26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also” (Cross reading – 1 John 3:10-24)*

This month, I strongly pray and believe God that you will let your faith work out your salvation in redemption.

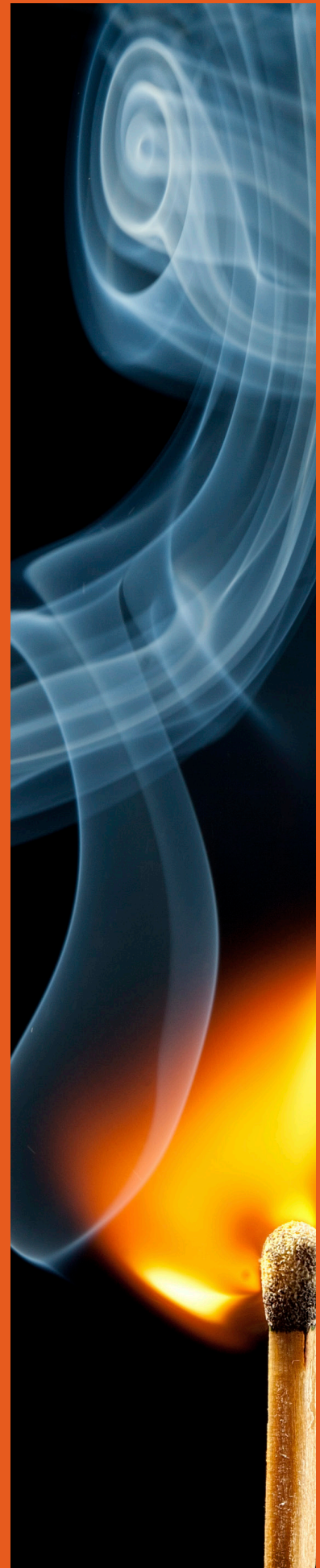

## THE FAITH THAT WORKS HAVE FAITH IN GOD

*Mark 11:20-24 “And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. 21 And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away. 22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them”*

*Romans 8:35-39 “Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord”*

King David the Psalmist put it this way in Psalm 121, look upwards to the hills where your help comes from – in another way, HAVE FAITH IN GOD! In challenging times the integrity and authenticity of our faith in God is put to the test. Let your faith not be on your job or from wherever to get your sustenance from. These things fail. The true test comes when pressures are high, jobs are lost and businesses fail to deliver – this is the time when we know who we believe our source to be – Psalms 23; Acts 20:21.

When we begin to nurse the spirit of having faith in God without having a plan B, faith will work in us and through us. In this way we will see mountains turning into plains, valleys being filled, the rough becoming smooth and the crooked becoming straight - (Isaiah 40:3-5). Having Faith in God is a dedication of trust on the integrity of the creator God. Just look at the faith you put on your SATNAV to take you to an unfamiliar places. Yet even they lead one astray and fail at times. God is the map writer and the guide, He will never fail you.

Jesus spoke in Mark 11:20-24 requesting the disciples (fellow believers in Him) to ‘HAVE FAITH IN GOD’ in response to their being in awe of the event that had happened previously in Mark 11:12-14. He had cursed a fig tree, which eventually became just as He said it would become. Jesus spoke there as son of man, that is, in His humanity (the book of Mark gospel helps to explain the working of God in Christ Jesus as son of man - humanity). In other words, Jesus was informing them that it was possible also through them as disciples (followers of Christ), which you are also, to ‘HAVE FAITH IN GOD’. This is what makes us work out our salvation of and for the good and goodness of God in us.



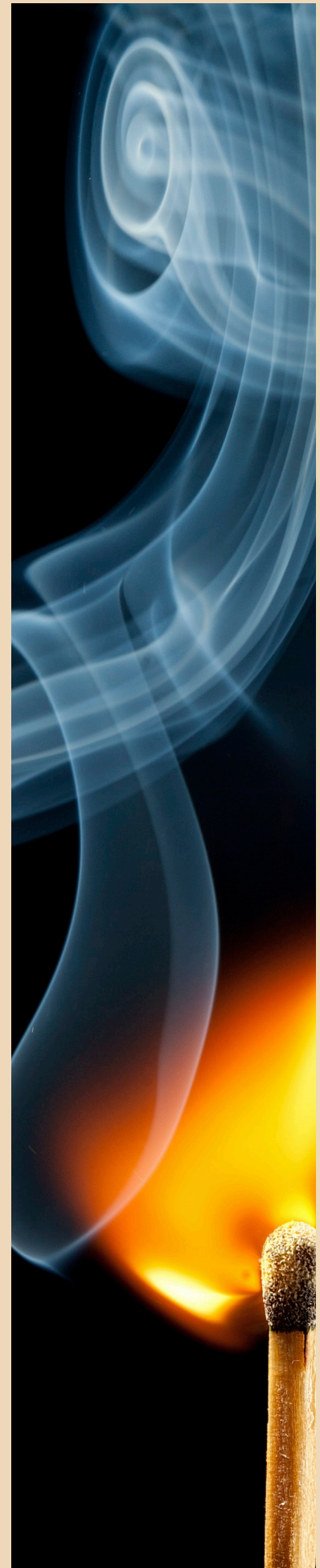
To 'Have Faith In God' means having faith in the 'Word of God'; that the promised and earnest intent of God for us in His plans, purposes and pursuits will surely come to pass no matter what the situations and circumstances are for us. We need to have undivided trust in God, meaning no room for doubts to the sayings of God in and through us as in Proverbs 4:20-22; Mark 11:23-24, knowing full well that God rewards those who diligently have faith in Him – Hebrews 11:6; Proverbs 22:29. We need to build up a strong desire on and for the WORD of God, so that our faith will unceasingly work for us.

The Faith that works is the faith built by a continuous hearing of the WORD of God as says in Romans 10:17. For some men have no Faith as says 2 Thessalonians 3:1-2.

2 Thessalonians 3:1-2 "Furthermore, brethren, do pray for us, that the Word of the Lord may speed on (spread rapidly and run its course) and be glorified (extolled) and triumph, even as [it has done] with you, 2 And that we may be delivered from perverse (improper, unrighteous) and wicked (actively malicious) men, for not everybody has faith and is held by it." (Amplified)

The simple reason could be because Faith is built by steadfast hearing of the Word of God which if you don't build it up, on days of challenges you will doubt God and succumb to the lesser instead of the greater. It's the craving for God's word that Job in Job 23:12 says he desires God's word more than his necessary food. The same act of grace you can find of the Psalmist David in Psalms 119:89, 97-100, 105 and 130. Their respective strong desires kept their faith not only built up but strong to work out their respective salvation in all the challenges that befell them.

To 'Have Faith In God' that works, means loving God and allowing His love to take hold of you and direct you plans, purposes and pursuit in Life. Faith will always work if there is an established love for God in us to trust Him and His word in all matter that concerns us unswervingly. This is what Apostle Paul means in Romans 8:35-39, where he says that there is no force, mountain, valley, trials, hunger, sickness, nakedness and more that can take his heart from the love of God and love for God. That no changing times or circumstances can make him underestimate his faith



because the love of God and the love for God will always enhance his faith to work out an answer. When you allow the genuine love of God to garrison your faith in the word of God, you will see that the act of serving God and obeying His word or commands is not grievous, burdensome, oppressive and taskmaster instructions. Having Faith through loving God ensures and assures that God will always commend what He commands.

*1 John 5:1-3 “Everyone who believes (adheres to, trusts, and relies on the fact) that Jesus is the Christ (the Messiah) is a born-again child of God; and everyone who loves the Father also loves the one born of Him (His offspring). 2 By this we come to know (recognize and understand) that we love the children of God: when we love God and obey His commands (orders, charges)—[when we keep His ordinances and are mindful of His precepts and His teaching]. 3 For the [true] love of God is this: that we do His commands [keep His ordinances and are mindful of His precepts and teaching]. And these orders of His are not irksome (burdensome, oppressive, or grievous)” (Amplified)*

The Faith that works is built on the love for God and His WORD. When this becomes the synergy of operation in our day to day life, there is no mountain, valley, rough place and crooked path of life that can be a stumbling block in us getting to God’s eternal plans, purposes and pursuit for us in REDEMPTION.

Therefore GO for the WORD, through the act of loving God, knowing your FAITH WILL WORK. Amen!

## THE FAITH THAT WORKS

### THE VITALITY OF BEING EFFECTIVE & EFFECTUAL

*1 John 5:4-5 “For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our Faith. “Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?”*

*Philemon 6 “That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus”*

*Galatians 5:6 “For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth anything, nor uncircumcision; but Faith which worketh by Love”*

As we examine the vitality and essence of the faith that works in life, what comes to mind is the place of Faith in the expression of love or visa viz. As God’s children and achievers in Christ Jesus, by the act of Faith we take a stand to live in all areas of our lives, yet the Bible says that it takes love to ensure that our faith for living is efficient (effectual) and effective. Being efficient that is effectual, is to do things well; while being effective is to do the right things well and produce results, that is, to bring forth fruit in due season according to the working of God’s grace in your life.

To live colourful, triumphant and overcome in life, the scriptures tell us that it is by an act of Faith working through Love in the deed of Christ Jesus in His redemption acts

and process for us. That's what 1 John 5:4-5 and Philemon 6 indicates. Knowing full well that in Christ Jesus as an Achiever what is vital and prominent is not just about who you are – circumcised or uncircumcised - but how you work your faith to become who you are – Faith working through Love - (Galatians 3:26-29; Galatians 5:6; Romans 10:11-13; Colossians 3:10-11).

Faith is acting on the instruction of whom you believe in order to become what you believe of and in Him. More appropriately, Faith is acting on the Word of God in order to be or become what God's plans, purposes and pursuits are about you. In order for you to be, your faith has to work. I want you to know full well that the enemy, the devil and cohorts per se are not after your finances, marriages, business, careers and more but are after your FAITH. If they can get your faith to deny God or place of denial towards God with an unbelieving act; such that you can doubt, distrust and question the integrity and authenticity of God's Word, they can get hold of your being in order to ruin and annihilate your finances, marriages, businesses and more. He tried to make Job deny God and give up on His Faith in God. But Job in all his trials and temptations kept His Faith intact and eventually there was a double recovery of all he once lost such that the enemy and cohorts could not contend. He stood on His faith and determined that His love for God in it would not tarnish - Job 19:25-27; Job 42:10-17; Romans 8:35-39.

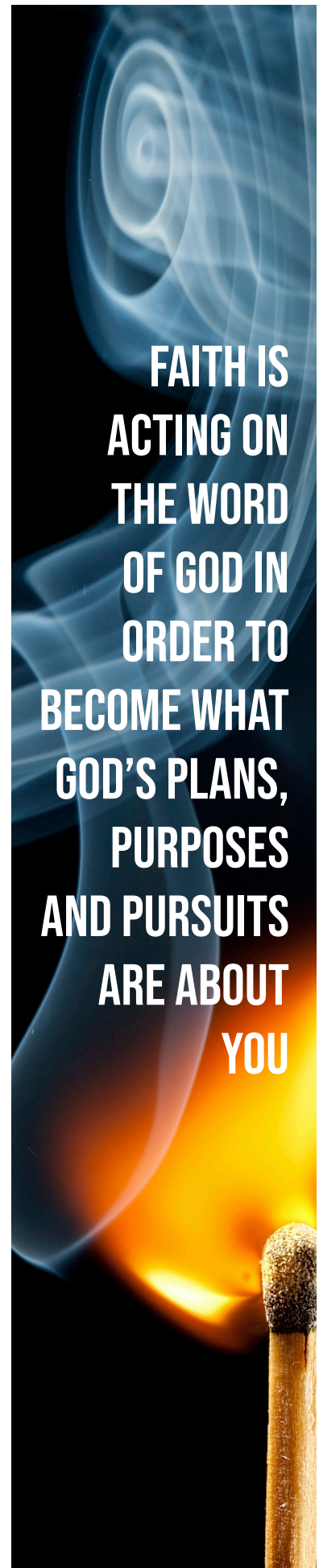

**3 UNIFIED ELEMENTS – HOPE, FAITH & LOVE!**

*1 Corinthians 13:13 "And now abideth Faith, Hope, Charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity"*

*Romans 5:1-5 "Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: 2 by whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand,*

*and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 3 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; 4 and patience, experience; and experience, hope: 5 and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us”*

The above scriptures of 1 Corinthians 13:13 and Romans 5:1-5 help to illustrate three vital elements that give worth to life which just as they are spiritual, they are also legal and vital to enhance the achievers’ lifestyle in an exalted position. These three vital elements are hope, faith and love.

- HOPE – Sets life goals and takes shame away from us
- FAITH – Brings life set goals to pass.
- LOVE – Lubricates and sustains and strengthens our hope and faith to make life worth living.

These ingredients that make life worth living are so vital if we must have lively achievers’ wellbeing. However, in this edition we will be considering the vitality of these elements to ascertain the faith that works. Seeing how vital they are and how they work together in making us become what we are born to be and in achieving our set goals and aspirations in life.

## THE FAITH THAT WORKS

### THE VITALITY OF HOPE

*Hebrews 11:1 “Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen”.*

Hope is a vital entity of FAITH. In other words, Faith is insured and assured when it works in the company of hope. Hope is the element that sets life goals to enable Faith to function effectively and effectually. A hope is a desire based on the promise of God personified or generalised. This promise communicates a possibility of God’s blessing to the individual, family, nations and encourages the soul. If one will plant this seed into the soil of the heart, and if the soil is kept right, it will bring forth a harvest of faith. Bible hope is faith in seed form.

However every human being has hope planted in them. That’s why each day we all rise up with the hope that something good will come our way or rather will happen to us. However, HOPE can be of natural and spiritual instinct. The difference is that the natural act of hope does not measure along in the eternal effect of spiritual hope embedded in the reborn spirit of man.

*1 Corinthians 2:14-16 “But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man. 16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ”*

But first, let us define natural (every day) hope, and then look at how it differs from

spiritual (scriptural-based) hope.

Natural Hope:

(Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia)

- Hope is the state which promotes the desire of positive outcomes related to events and circumstances in one's life or in the world at large.
- Hope is the "feeling that what is wanted can be had or that events will turn out for the best" or the act of "look[ing] forward to something with desire and reasonable confidence" or "feel[ing] that something desired may happen".
- Other definitions include: "to cherish a desire with anticipation"; "to desire with expectation of obtainment"; or "to expect with confidence".
- In the English language the word can occur either as a noun or as a verb, although hope as a concept has a similar meaning in either use
- (Webster's Revised Unabridged Dictionary)

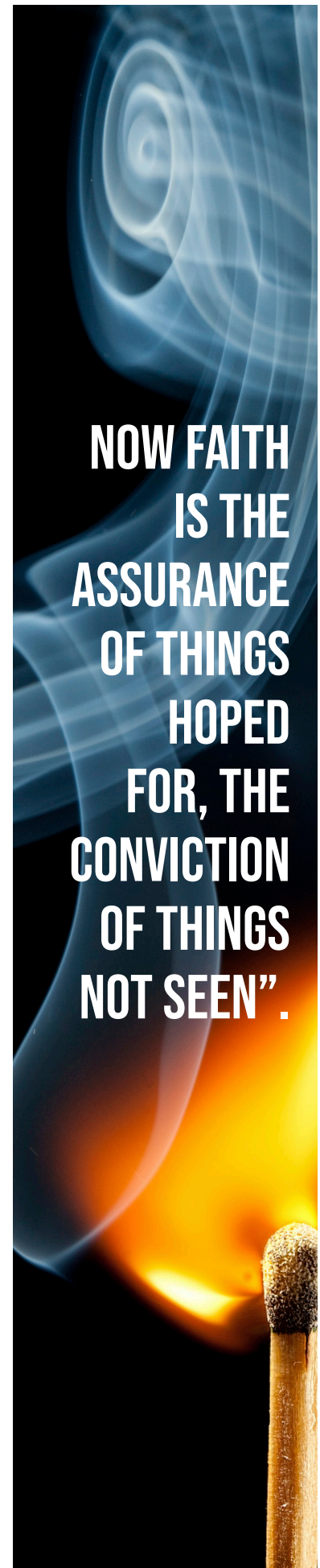
Noun

- A desire of some good, accompanied with an expectation of obtaining it, or a belief that it is obtainable; an expectation of something, which is thought to be desirable; confidence; pleasing expectancy.
- One who, or that which, gives hope, furnishes ground of expectation, or promises desired good.
- That which is hoped for; an object of hope.

Verb

- To entertain or indulge hope; to cherish a desire of good, or of something welcome, with expectation of obtaining it or belief that it is obtainable; to expect; — usually followed by for.
- To place confidence; to trust with confident expectation of good; — usually followed by in.

By definition as ascribed above in the two distinguished dictionaries, the concept of Hope is very much vital and paramount for any man to live. The natural hope may or may not have a strong foundation, and may exist only as a feeling, or mental attitude. However, this hope gives us the reason to go on, based on a notion that our desires in respect of our plans, purposes and pursuit to an exalted position can be achieved. The natural hope then is based on the natural instincts and reasoning, convincing as it

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may seem to be, is not an absolute guarantee. In this world, a good result is never absolutely guaranteed however not the less when it's not divinely imparted and directed.

### **The Spiritual (Biblical) Hope**

The Bible hope is similar to natural hope, in that it is also a belief in the possible expectation of a desire. The difference is that the foundation for Bible Hope is not founded on earthly reason, but rather on the promises given to us in the Bible from God.

*Romans 15:4 "For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope"*

*Ephesians 2:12 "...remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world".*

Hope is Faith in Seed Form – Faith is Hope in Final Form!

Both natural hope and Bible-based hope start with a desire, a longing, or a need. Add to this desire a reason for it to be expected and you have hope. The Bible-based hope is a desire that has a corresponding promise from God. In Bible hope, the promises of God contained within the written scriptures are the foundation for this positive future expectation. The desires remain our desires, but now they have the added benefit of being a desire that is also an approved scriptural possibility. These desires are transformed into Bible-based hope by the realization that they are in agreement with the will, which is the word of God. By this understanding the vitality of hope is that it transformed into an object of faith by direct and personal communication of God to our hearts. This faith will in turn transform the desire into reality in our lives.

*Romans 10:17 "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.*

*Hebrews 11:1 "Now faith is the substance (ownership, legal right) of things hoped for, the evidence of things not (yet) seen.*

### **From Hopeless To Hope and Then To Faith**

We do know that any person, who does not know Christ, is lost and without hope in the world and in life with God. One day when he is presented with the Gospel of the Bible-based hope and he believes, such receives Christ as his personal Saviour and Lord. Christ becomes now his hope. His future is insured and assured, but he still has physical needs in this life.

*Colossians 1:27 "To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory"*

*Romans 8:24-25 "For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For*

*who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience”.*

One of physical needs of such new person in Christ with scriptural-based hope may be the need for a physical healing. His need for healing creates a desire in him for healing. Learning further about the scriptures, he comes to realize that physical healing is also included within God’s redemption plan, and that he can be healed through the power and grace of God. The realization that physical healing is a scriptural-based possibility creates hope. Hope is the positive future expectation of receiving God’s promises fulfilled in our lives. Hope is a desire that the answer is found in the promises of God. It is this vitality of hope that makes FAITH work.

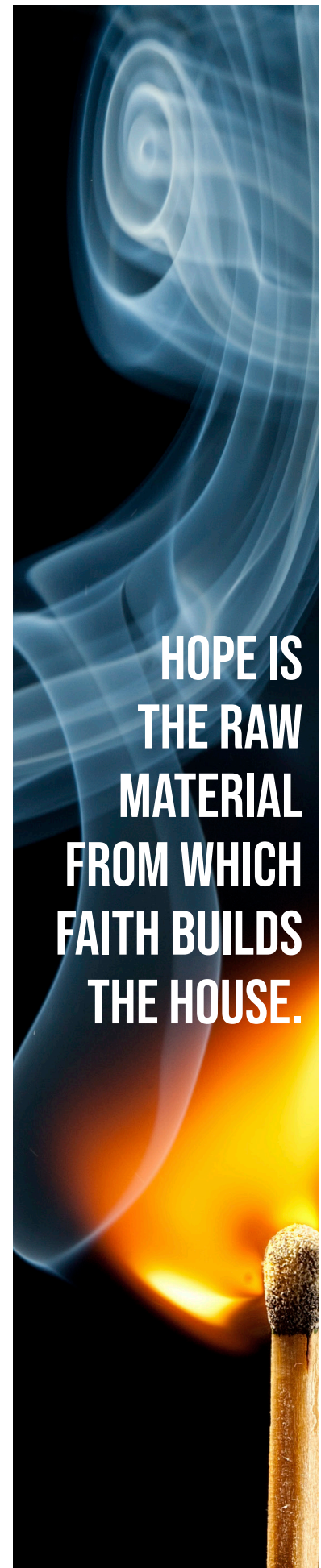
*Hebrews 11:1-2 “Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, [a]the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].” (Amplified)*

*Romans 15:13 “May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope”.*

*Titus 3:7 “so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life”*

If we diligently persevere in seeking God on a matter, hope will turn to faith, and our desire to reality.

- Hope is the first step in our receiving ‘things’ from God. For, ‘faith is the ownership or reality of things hoped for, the evidence of things not yet seen.’
  - Hope is the start of the walk of faith, hence to give vitality for Faith to work.
  - Hope believes you can have it someday. Faith believes that you have it now (in your heart).
  - Hope is the possibility; faith is the surety. Faith transforms hopes into realities.
  - Hope is the raw material from which faith builds the house.
- Transforming our godly desires into reality is the



purpose of hope and faith! I challenge you to go ahead and hope freely in God, you will not be disappointed, because hope is the vitality that makes faith work.

*Romans 5:5 “. . . and hope does not disappoint (make us ashamed), because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us” (Emphasis mine).*

*1 Peter 1:3 “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead”.*

It is up to us to take our needs and desires to our Lord God and seek Him through His word according to all Christ accomplished for us in REDEMPTION. Only through His word can we accurately judge our desires. Those desires that can stand the test of His word are viable candidates for reality.

*Hebrew 6:11-12 “But we do [[a]strongly and earnestly] desire for each of you to show the same diligence and sincerity [all the way through] in realizing and enjoying the full assurance and development of [your] hope until the end, 12 In order that you may not grow disinterested and become [spiritual] sluggards, but imitators, behaving as do those who through faith ([b]by their leaning of the entire personality on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness) and by practice of patient endurance and waiting are [now] inheriting the promises” (Amplified).*

For without hope God has nothing for which faith can make reality. For HOPE is the vitality on which Faith works.

## THE FAITH THAT WORKS THE VITALITY OF FAITH

*Galatians 5:6 “For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth anything, nor uncircumcision; but Faith which worketh by Love.”*

*Hebrews 11:6 “But without Faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.”*

*Romans 14:23 “And he that doubteth is damned if he eats, because he eateth not of faith: for whatsoever is not of faith is sin.”*

*Ephesians 2:8 “For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God”*

I have come to know in the course of my pastoral responsibility that people who live with unfulfilled life dreams of their plans, purposes and pursuits, could end up in frustration and destruction watching their aspirations, hopes and faith being shattered. It's painful to see people's earnest desire dreams and destiny come to



nothing. God has given and bestowed grace on us to succeed, triumph and win in life.

For these the Bible has great input to say about the vitality of our FAITH if we must achieve our goals in life and become what we ought to be. Let's consider these scriptures then:-

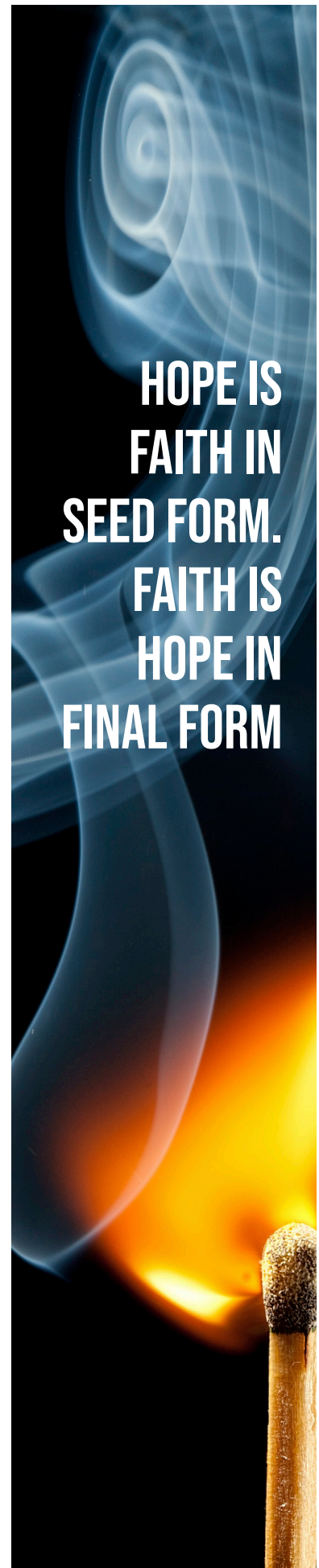
- Hebrews 11:6 – says that you cannot Please God without Faith. (Deuteronomy 32:20, Luke 18:8)
- Romans 14:23 – Says that anything Done without Faith is sin.
- 2 Corinthians 5:7 – Says that we Walk by Faith and not by sight.
- Habakkuk 2:4 – Says that the just shall Live by His own Faith
- Ephesians 2:8 – Says that by Faith we are Saved through God's grace.
- Faith Testimonies of countless people healed by our Lord Jesus Christ were as a result of their Faith. Luke 7:9; Matthew 9:29; Matthew 5:28.

FAITH is spiritual, legal and vital to our Christian walk and is important in becoming that which God intended us to be. Faith is of God. Faith is neither a doctrine nor a creed. It is a product of the Spirit and comes from the Word of God - John 6:63; Romans 10:17. Meaning that FAITH can come and go when attention is not given to generate and sustain it through the Word of God. There is no single being that has walked on the face of the earth with meaningful and achievable kingdom results that has nothing to show from a life of Faith. The reason is because Faith is the Victory by which life warfare can be overcome in every level of life – 1 John 5:4-5.

Faith is bringing the unseen to the seen world – 2 Corinthians 4:13, 18.

We can therefore sum up the vitality of faith by the scriptural truth of Hebrews chapter eleven.

- Vs 1 - Faith gives substance(flesh) to our hopes and aspirations
- Vs 1 – Faith is evidence – legal tender, assurance and confidence.
- Vs 3 – Faith gives understanding
- Vs 4 – Faith offers an excellent and better sacrifice.
- Vs 5 – Faith translates and transfigures.



- Vs 6 – Faith pleases God.
- Vs 7 – Faith gives warning of coming danger
- Vs 8 – Faith receives an inheritance.
- Vs 9 – Faith gives or creates patience
- Vs 11 – Faith gives strength.
- Vs 12 – 40 – Faith produces and makes the heroes of faith.

Yet as vital and as this essence of Faith is, it's not workable says the Word of God unless it allows HOPE as earlier discussed and LOVE to be the main stream or river course in which it flows and operates; and in order to achieve life goals according to the plans, purposes and pursuit of God for us in REDEMPTION.

## THE FAITH THAT WORKS

### THE VITALITY OF LOVE

*1 John 5:1–5 “Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that Loveth him that begat Loveth him also that is begotten of him. By this we know that we Love the children of God, when we Love God, and keep his commandments. For this is the Love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our Faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?”*

*Romans 5:5, 8 “And hope maketh not ashamed; because the Love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. . . But God commendeth his Love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us”*

*Revelation 2:4 “Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first Love”*

*1 John 4:7–10 “Beloved, let us Love one another: for Love is of God; and every one that Loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that Loveth not knoweth not God; for God is Love. In this was manifested the Love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is Love, not that we Loved God, but that he Loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins”*

Just like Faith, Love is a product of the Spirit. God is love. God is a Spirit and those who worship Him do it in their spirit and in truth, for God have no place for lies and deception; Love is of the Spirit. Genuine Bible love is spiritual not natural. It is not a product of an act of man's creation. God is love and anyone whose intention is to know, understand and manifest a genuine kind of love needs to connect to God's DNA of love. Love is an attitude, a deliberate choice, an exercise of the will, a choice of life and is much more than a mere feeling; it is an expression of the nature of God. God is love! Which means the definition of Love is God - 1 John 4:7–10. Let's consider love in diversity for a clearer understanding of the kind of love vitality being implied in this AFD EDITION.

There are three MAJOR kinds of love:

- **Phileo Grk (of the soul i.e. mind, emotion)**

Love relationship in family - between parent and child/children. The Family kind of love. It means to be fond of; it is based on feelings and not on principle. It's never used of man's love to or for God. This is human or natural kind of love. Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Genesis 8:19; Ephesians 6:4; Colossians 3:21. This kind of love is however essential and crucial for a family wellbeing and bonding.

- **Eros Grk (of the Physical i.e. body)**

Sexual love; purely intended and reserved for the married, that is, within the bond of marriage. It's neither for fornication, adultery or any act of immorality or formats. However, Lust and immoral desires have gotten some into it. Hebrews 13:4; 1 Corinthians 7:1-5; 1 Corinthians 5:1-2. This is based on looks and physical desires, not on principle.

- **Agape Grk (of the spirit i.e. spiritual, divine)**

God's kind of love; unconditional, limitless, divine, spiritual. It transcends race, gender, generation, culture, family, physical, personal (self) and such likes. 1 Corinthians 13. Agape love is the bedrock that helps to ensure, strengthen and maintain also the living out of the Phileo and Eros kind of love in all life endeavours. Agape love is based on principle – be it towards things or people.

**Note:** The Phileo or Eros kinds of Love need to be ruled and governed; and possibly bring under subjection or control by the exercising of the Agape kind of love otherwise it will hinder our fellowship and relationship with God and possibly lead to sin. Examples:

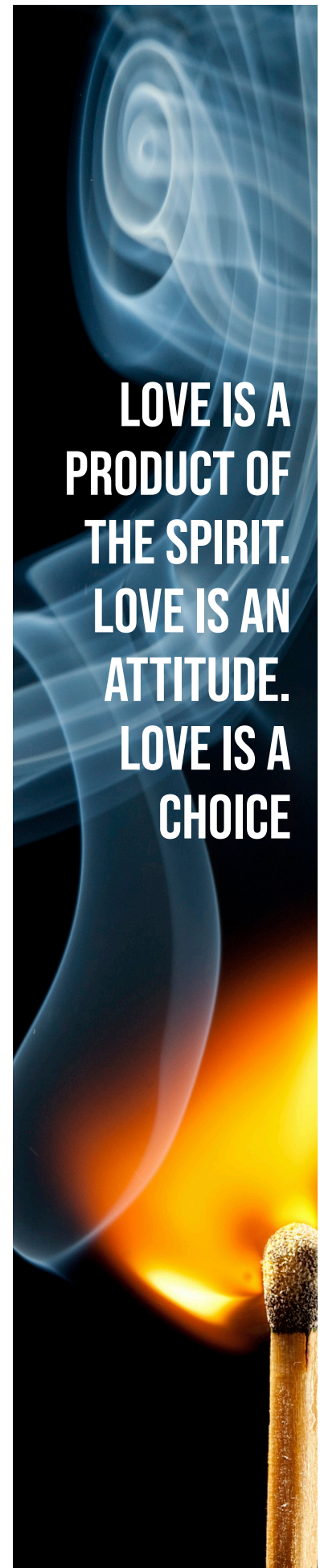
- **Eros (Sexual love)**

As Marriage couples, use only fasting and prayer period of mutual agreements in knowledge and understanding to abstain.

1 Corinthians 7:5 "Do not refuse and deprive and defraud each other [of your due marital rights], except perhaps by mutual consent for a time, so that you may devote yourselves unhindered to prayer. But afterwards resume marital relations, lest Satan tempt you [to sin] through your lack of restraint of sexual desire." (Amplified)

- **Phileo (Parental love)**

Don't let the feelings of love rule your life more than your faith love in God and towards God - Romans 8:35-39.



*1 Samuel 2:22-36 “Now Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. 23 And he said unto them, Why do ye such things? for I hear of your evil dealings by all this people. 24 Nay, my sons; for it is no good report that I hear: ye make the Lord’s people to transgress. 25 If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the Lord, who shall intreat for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the Lord would slay them. 26 And the child Samuel grew on, and was in favour both with the Lord, and also with men. 27 And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the Lord, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh’s house? 28 And did I choose him out of all the tribes of Israel to be my priest, to offer upon mine altar, to burn incense, to wear an ephod before me? and did I give unto the house of thy father all the offerings made by fire of the children of Israel? 29 Wherefore kick ye at my sacrifice and at mine offering, which I have commanded in my habitation; and honourest thy sons above me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel my people? 30 Wherefore the Lord God of Israel saith, I said indeed that thy house, and the house of thy father, should walk before me for ever: but now the Lord saith, Be it far from me; for them that honour me I will honour, and they that despise me shall be lightly esteemed. 31 Behold, the days come, that I will cut off thine arm, and the arm of thy father’s house, that there shall not be an old man in thine house. 32 And thou shalt see an enemy in my habitation, in all the wealth which God shall give Israel: and there shall not be an old man in thine house for ever. 33 And the man of thine, whom I shall not cut off from mine altar, shall be to consume thine eyes, and to grieve thine heart: and all the increase of thine house shall die in the flower of their age. 34 And this shall be a sign unto thee, that shall come upon thy two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas; in one day they shall die both of them. 35 And I will raise me up a faithful priest, that shall do according to that which is in mine heart and in my mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before mine anointed for ever. 36 And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left in thine house shall come and crouch to him for a piece of silver and a morsel of bread, and shall say, Put me, I pray thee, into one of the priests’ offices, that I may eat a piece of bread”.*

Love is a fruit and not a gift. Fruits are grown while gifts are imparted. Genuine Bible love – Agape - is born and is a product of the Spirit. Considering our subject of discussion, let us come to the light in examining some characteristics of Agape kind of love as vital to enhance the working of Faith.

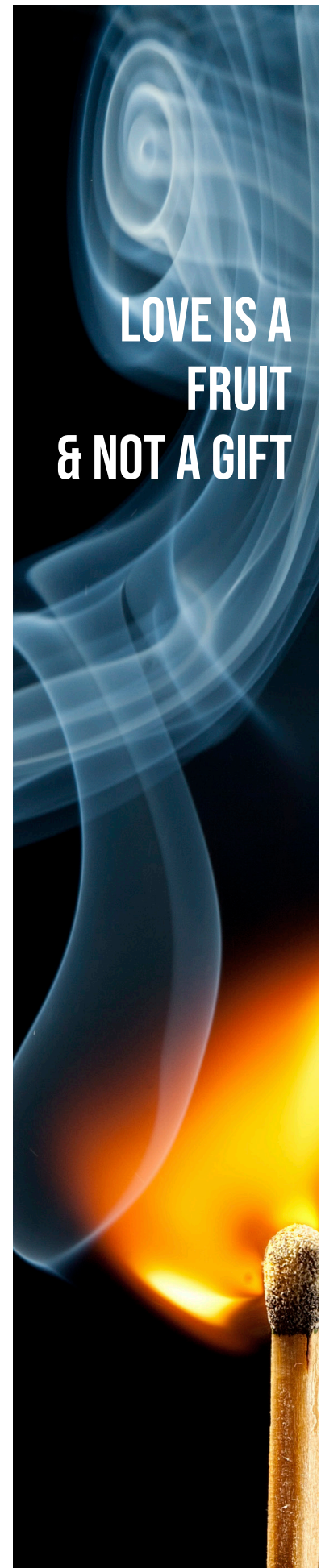
- 1 John 3-4:24 - Love is God and God is love, meaning God is the definition and embodiment of genuine love.
- John 3:16 - Love gives power of initiative, is a giver, sacrificial.
- James 2:8 – Love is the royal law for the redeemed who are a royal priesthood – kings & priests unto God (Revelation 5:9-10; 1 Peter 2:5, 9)
- Romans 13:8, 10 - Love works no ill to self or others and it’s the fulfilment of all God’s commands.
- Romans 12:9 –11; Philippians 2:3-4 - There is no hypocrisy or dissemination in love. It sees people through in life and does not see through people.

- John 4:17–18 - No fear, intimidation, harassment and torment in love.
- 1 Corinthians 13:13 - Love is the greatest gift in ranking and its characteristics are imbedded in this scripture - 1 Corinthians 13.
- 1 Peter 4:7–9 - Love is the end of all commandments and supreme to all things.
- Col 3:12–14 - Love is supreme and above all things.
- 1 Corinthians 2:31 – 13:1-13 – Love is the excellent way to enhance spiritual gifts and spiritual fruit of the Spirit - (Galatians 5:6, 13, 22-23)
- Galatians 6:1; John 8:1-11; John 4 – Love restores the weak ones back to Faith and not the accuser or fault finder of the brethren.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 – Love is the most excellent way to excel, pilot one's life and to have an overflowing life in divine endowments.
- John 15:13 – Love is considerate.
- 1 Corinthians 13 – Love is patient, kind, not boastful or arrogant, not selfish and keeps record of no wrong.
- Psalm 119:165 - Love forgives and does not offend.
- 1 Corinthians 8:1–3 - Love edifies and builds.
- Proverbs 10:12, 1 Peter 4:8, John 3:16 – Love overlooks a multitude of evils and sins
- ... And many more in searching the scriptures.

Your regard, respect and value for love determine how you reign in it and the virtues that get back to your life. When one walks in love, one is then prepared to live through life as God's instrument of grace on the pathway to achieve and become.

Love is the hallmark of the New Testament Christian Faith for any great achiever or one intending to become such in God. Hence its vitality as to make our faith in Christ work was strongly commanded (not as an advice) by our Lord Jesus Christ.

*John 13:34–35 "A new commandment I give unto you, that ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one*



*another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another”*

And it's upon this unity of grace in God's eternal plans, purposes and pursuit which are born from the Spirit of love that God's commanded blessings are lavished and manifest in and through believers in life and ministry. This is what makes Faith to work in and through us.

*Psalm 133 “. . . Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments; As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore”*

## **FAITH AT WORK**

### **Jesus Christ - Our Living Epistle!**

*Acts 2:22 “Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know”*

*John 13:1-3 “Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.”*

*Hebrew 5:7-10 “Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared; Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him; Called of God a high priest after the order of Melchizedek”*

God wants you to live THE GREATER LIFE, triumph and reign in life through the Faith that works in Hope and love. The days of mere wishful way of existence to deal with the affairs of life is over for all those who are born of God and want to let the word of God have a root in them. We live in challenging times and every child of God must as a matter of reality live by what they are made to be in order to authenticate their faith in God – exalted to as kings and priests unto God on earth – 1 John 4:17.

You need to take your stand in Christ in that which affects and opposes your faith. Faith works by God's grace already made available to and for you in REDEMPTION; by this you can be able to triumph, reign, rule and win in matters of life. This will stand in the vitality of Hope and Love, to lubricate your FAITH TO WORK, and you can overcome over all that has limited you and questioned the integrity of your Faith in God.

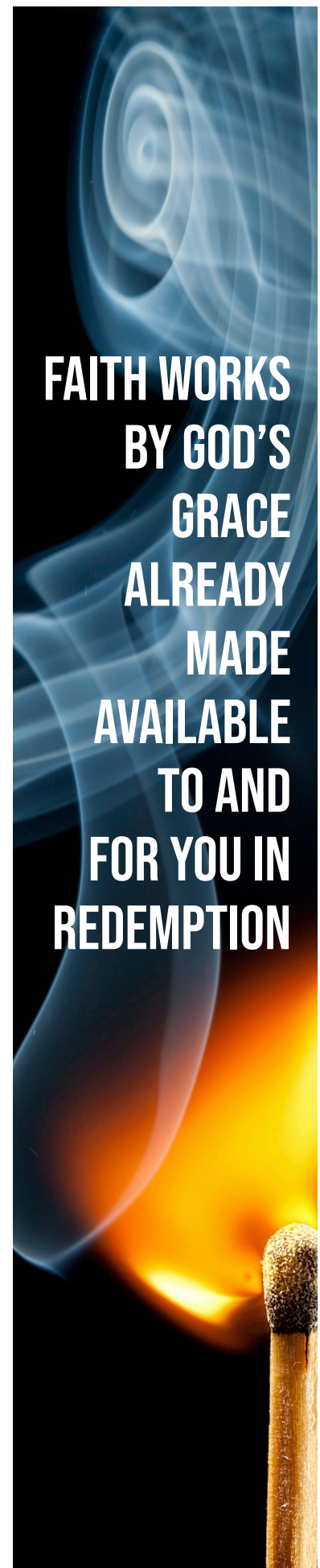
Our Lord Jesus Christ, in the days of his life in the flesh – humanity, that is, as son of man” – reigned in life through Hope and Love by the abundance of all things supplied by the

Father God. He reigned over and dominated principalities and powers, overcame temptations and trials, uprooted bitterness, envy and every work of the flesh as depicted in Galatians 5:19-21; Matthew 4:1-13 (Luke 4:1-13); 1 John 2:15-17.

Jesus love knows no bounds hence He ruled and reigned over all, in life on earth in His humanity in the midst of all odds. He had a choice to either give in, give up or to be in charge and in control; and of course He chose to reign that He might give us an assurance of hope. It is possible to live and reign in life on earth until He comes to have us home – 1 John 4:17; Romans 5:17, 21. Therefore let's arise, put an end to living in your own strength and skills and on life that is based on your intellect and human deprivation. Let's put our Faith to work through the vitality that is already made available for us in Christ Jesus by His REDEMPTION plans, purposes and pursuit for our exaltation. Let's begin to live life to the full, taking charge and reigning in life as a triumphant, victorious and more than a conqueror people of God and not as cowards. Human life is limited, is more than a mere accumulation of wealth or being physically strong. You can't measure God's endowment with physical prosperity. Let's begin to exercise ourselves unto the FAITH THAT WORKS, for in it we shall live well on this side of heaven until the Lord returns.

## THE FAITH THAT WORKS

### Grand Finale

*Galatians 5:6* “For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but Faith which worketh by Love.”

*Ephesians 3:17, 19* “That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, . . . And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God.”

*Ephesians 4:1 – 3* “I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”

*Galatians 5:22-23* “But the fruit of the Spirit is LOVE, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, FAITH, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law”

Faith and Love are an expression of obedience to God. Obeying God is as a result of the revelation knowledge of God and His Word. It is not dogmatic or an act of religious know-how, tradition and conscience of any source. Faith is both a gift (imparted) and fruit (character) of the Holy Spirit - 1 Corinthians 12:9; Galatians 5:22. As a fruit it speaks of faithfulness. Hence one can say that faith and Love are both fruit of the Spirit.

Ephesians 3:17, 19 show that our faith should be rooted and grounded (established) in the love of Christ. Matt 5:23–26 (for illustration)

Ephesians 4:1–3 indicates that if we must love, we need to make an effort. Make everything possible to love to enable our faith in God to be effective and effectual – efficient. To love is gentle and humble – complete humility and patience in bearing with each other as a way to love.

In Galatians 5:6 we see that in Christ Jesus nothing has value except Faith expressing itself in Love. Faith works by love when we take God’s Word as it is without argument. This we can see in the following biblical expressions and hallmarks of Love:

Faith is the hand – legal tender – that takes the things we need from God and delivers them into our hand. Everything that Jesus purchased (Redeemed) for us on Calvary can be obtained by FAITH - Ephesians 1:3; 2 Peter 1:3-5; Colossians 1:13-14; John 10:0; 3 John 2). Faith is acting correspondingly to the Word of God, that is – Belief in Action.

One of the reasons why FAITH is not WORKING for some of the Believing Achievers as they lay claim to be people of Faith is simply because they do not have understanding of what the Word of God says – Faith that works by Love and Faith that lives by Hope.



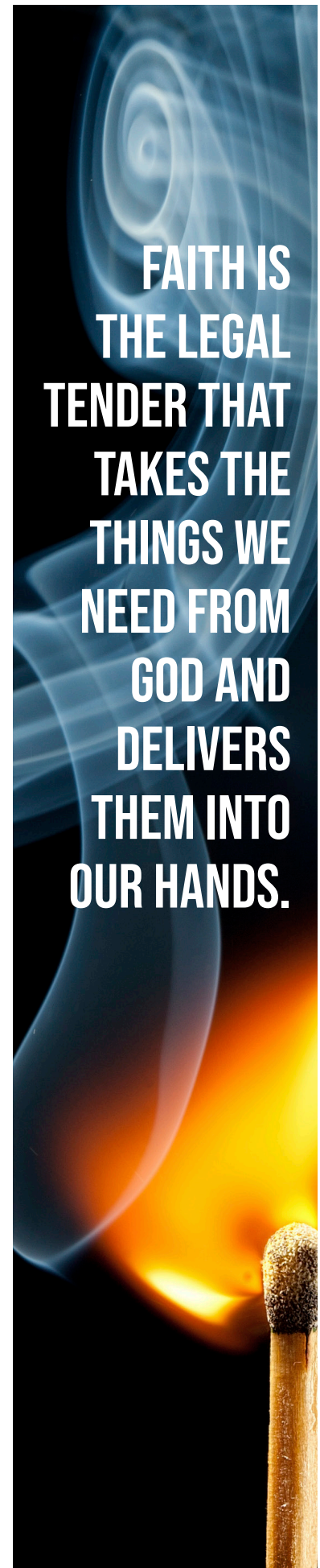
This is what will measure up to all of the principles and stands set down in the Word of God. When we are Love-conscious, Hope-conscious and not Sin-conscious, our Faith will bring us to our place of triumph to reign in life.

*Revelation 2:1-7 “... 4 Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love. 5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent. 6 But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. 7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God”.*

*Mark 11:20-24 “And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them”.*

*Romans 5:4-5 “And endurance (fortitude) develops maturity of [a]character (approved faith and [b]tried integrity). And character [of this sort] produces [the habit of] [c]joyful and confident hope of eternal salvation. 5 Such hope never disappoints or deludes or shames us, for God’s love has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit Who has been given to us.” (Amplified)*

Beloved dear reader, you are destined not only to have good success and triumphantly reign in exalted place of grace but to become in life as an ACHIEVER thriving through the vitality of faith that works in hope and love. We can deduce from the foregone illustrations that in our exercising of Faith through our natural instinct or as a fruit or spiritual gift – we need the element of hope and love to authenticate its viability to make life worth living. This will bring forth the desire you long for and anticipated for your spouse, children, parents, family members, in-laws, relationship, your neighbour, career, business, friendship, church and more.

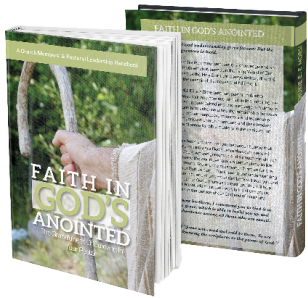

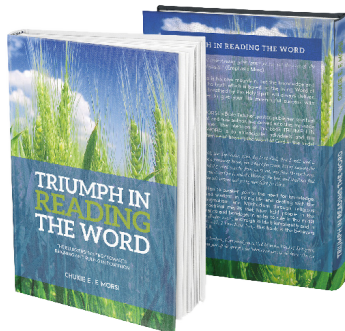

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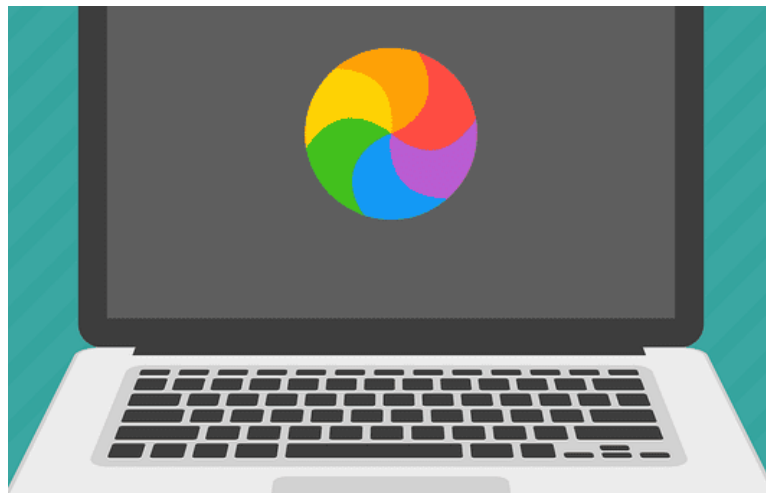
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WHEN YOU PRAY

I Sit in front of my laptop ready to get online. I type the website address in and expect the webpage to show up on my screen . . .



It doesn't - instead there is this circle, rotating. Round and round it goes . . . it's loading. I wait anxiously for a little while. "Is there anything wrong?" I ask myself. Nothing shows up, so I click again. Over and over I click in frustration and finally the circle goes away and a message comes on - that the page had failed to load.

I picture it in a similar way - that when we pray - the manifestation may not come to our physical senses immediately. You prayed, you asked and it's now loading. Going back and asking again confirms that you believe that the prayer was not heard and hence unanswered in the first place - so you ask again. You prayer for longer, louder, even fast for a further few days. But that is not what praying without ceasing is. It's about having a prayer life allowing you to be in constant fellowship with the Lord. Knowing His heart on issues and knowing His voice.

Even in the book of Daniel, the answer to their first prayer came after three days and the second one came after three weeks - and yet they came to learn that both prayers had been answered immediately. The Prince of Persia had held up the angel the second time.

When you pray - believe that you receive - and you shall have it. The prayer that comes after that is not a prayer of petition but of thanksgiving and appropriating that which has been answered; standing on the Word of God, building yourself up in the most holy faith. Nurturing and watering that word, speaking according to what the Word of God says.

*Hebrews 10:23 . . . Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;).*

Maybe the URL was mistyped; maybe the systems are down; maybe I wasn't even meant to see the website. What ever the case may be - I trust God and His timing. When you pick up the plough, do not look back.

*Luke 9:62 . . . But Jesus said to him, "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."*

*Matthew 21:22 . . . 22 And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive."*
