I want to thank you lord for the grace to come to fulfil that part of my word this morning, as we all know. They happen to be our revelation Sunday service. The month theme is "Having faith in God's faithfulness". Have faith. Have assurance. Confidence. Assurance, confidence. Trust. That God is faithful to his word irrespective of the circumstance you are dealing with it. You may deal with tomorrow. When you stand by God, God will have

the capacity, the synergy to deliver you, to emancipate you, to set you free, to bless you with the grace and blessings.

I want to share this morning what I call, "Being faithful toward God and toward man In God's faithfulness". Being faithful toward God and toward man In God's faithfulness. Sometimes as Christians, as God's people, in Christ Jesus. We forget that we have a mission on the face of the earth. We have to do business. Like Christ is saying, I'm asking my father for business. He has religion in his business. We stand in the place of honour and dignity. If you're not, if you're unproductive, you stand with mere men. Unproductive people. For about 22% of the people. We are in a place of business. And God is doing business. It's towards God, towards man. In all phases of human life, God wants us to know that he is faithful towards us. In our doing business with man. In our doing business with him. God wants us to be faithful. In those areas of our life. There's a lot of times that God has said we are so spiritual. A lot of times most things we do are badly done and when the effect of our bad work is coming to us, we think we are being faithful to God. No, it's our stupidity. Our foolishness. Our ignorance. Not knowing that we can't enjoy God's faithfulness when towards man we see we see with our two eyes we are bad people. When you're becoming irresponsible and unaccountable to a tax. Or your workplace or even your relationship.

And things can't get any wrong. Do you not know that there's no devil there, there's no demonthere. You have to discipline yourself. Do a re-evaluation of yourself. And do a little more check. And make an amendment to be better off. People don't take nonsense all the time from people. That was in the book of **1st Corinthians 4**, **verses 1-2** *It said Let a man account of all as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the ministries of God.*That's true. Moreover, it's required in stewards that the man be found faithful.

You see one of the costs of life to serve, every position you have in your life is a son. Let me say it again and every opportunity. And everything that God gives to you as a child of God is to serve. You're given a brain. It's to serve. You have muscles to use. It's to serve You have to wear your legs. It's to serve. They're supposed to be people. They're given accommodation. They have a shelter. It's to serve, I've seen a man who lives close to the church. A family by the church. Nobody dares ask him to make a cup of drink. God gives him a minister of Christ. It's to serve. It's like serving a community or serving a person. We must deal aware with selfishness, greed, and covetousness and entitlement out of our crystal if we want God to be a part of our journey in Christ Jesus. Distribute accumulation. I just send an opportunity for all of us to stop. Still working. We have been called to serve. As a pastor, to serve God and serve man. You serve God and serve man. Never continue to have adult children. You give preference to people to find a future through your service. In verse 1, he said, for it's not freedom that we are sinning. By serving this freedom, don't take it as a means to go back to where I am coming from. Some people have no guard grace they say now I've got what I wanted; I want to live in the flesh. He said in verse 13, he said, you should serve the brethren by love. Then that man, they are born of God. He should serve people. Following the scripture, we read in that **Luke 17** When you read from verse **5 to verse 10**, it speaks about, after you have done what you need to do, to serve people, it says, set yourself as an unprofitable servant. In other words, you are endowed to serve. If no one is there to thank you, it doesn't matter. As I said, if no one appreciates it, it doesn't matter. It doesn't matter. It's not to man, it's to God, first of all.

The sooner you feel that if nobody is there to thank you, when you feel that, I have it all. I'm in this position to alter and make a change and grow like that. Let me tell you, I've seen people in great heights that have come down and never rise again. When you lose an opportunity given to you, in your pride, in your arrogance, you may never rise again. I have seen a nobody in life that become and attain greatness in their life. I have seen, I have witnessed, I have seen. I have seen people who think that they have it all and they have come down and become flat. They never believed they will be there. Every endowment of God to serve God. You have to be faithful to God. When God allows you an opportunity to serve others.

Sometimes people don't even need to be preached to, the gospel. It's the life we live, that changes people. In that Christian Walk, in the life we live. I remember countless times,

people that have meet me in the working place. I have not even preached to them yet. To ask me questions. Are you a Christian? They watch your life. The bible says when they preached to us, they read by men. With the Bible they read. With the life we live, that's what they read, not what we say with our mouth. God demands accountability, responsibility in the presence of his word in our life. Towards Him and towards me. Apostle, Paul, then he said to put it this way, in **Acts 24 verse 16**. He said, Paul, an apostle, sorry, here I'm going to exercise myself to have always a conscious, voidful faith towards God and towards men and lead with that voidfulness, towards God and towards men. To have a conscious. To have a conscious.

In 1 Timothy, 3, verse 9 it says, holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscious. It says faith is a mystery. That's why faith is a doctrine. Faith is a doctrine. There's a mystery in this faith of consciousness. That is a Christian life. It's not a way of life. It's a life on its own. It's life. There's a mystery in this life. That what God will use to save me, is not what He will use to save you. Yet, we are all saved. By faith, but in different ways. Mystery of faith. Paul said, Timothy, hold the mystery of faith with pure conscience. Towards God and towards men. Unpolluted. Unadulterated. In Ephesians 1 verse 1, it says, Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ, by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus. One of the marks of our Christian faith, Apostle Paul was telling the Ephesian church, be faithful. We ought to be people who can come to being faithful.

You could be trusted. You know sometimes, you wonder how people can behave in a bigger, larger opportunities. Take for example, you are sent on an go and buy bread. A loaf of bread. You come back; you give no change to the person that sent you. Go and buy a piece of furniture. They give you money. You come back; you don't even give change to the person that sent you. You don't know the person who sent you. May eventually give back and say, you can keep the change? But you make sure that you don't give them back a change. Unfaithful spirit. Unfaithful attitude. An entitlement that's unscriptural. And many do it in a literary way. How do you think God will come into your hand bigger? Let me show you what Scripture says in Luke chapter 16. I'm going to read from the Bible. From verse 10 to 12. It says, he who is faithful in a very little thing is also faithful in much. And he who is dishonest in a very little thing is also dishonest in much. Therefore, if you are not faithful in the use of earthly wealth, who entrusts you true riches to you? And if you are not faithful in the use of that earthly wealth which belongs to another, whether God or man, of which you are a trustee, who gives you that which is your own?

Sometimes people say, God, make me great. You said, I'll be the head, not the tail. Lord, lift me up. Lord, make me as your ordinary believer. Lord, bless me with pure kind of prayer. But even little opportunity, here we are. We are faithful. God, He mentioned to us about being faithful toward God and toward man in God's faithfulness. If every little opportunity I give will become a fantastic, marital, marital thing, who will commit to you

bigger things? Somebody says, look after this for me. In his absence, or her absence, you either abandon it, or you don't look after it, or you use it against the instruction given to you. And you want one day you become great? It will happen. It may happen in the world, but for you as a child of God, God will not dishonour his word because of you. God will not break his word because of you. Two immutable things. God will not lie. He won't deny himself. He won't deny his word because of you. People will trust this into your hands. You can't face this. And you want to have, you want to be in that position? Do you want? You work in a place of work. You come to work. Work starts at 8 p.m. You arrive at 9, but you are registering at 8 p.m. Sorry, sorry. Work starts at 8 a.m. You arrive at 9 o'clock. You are registering and you came to work at 8 o'clock. And you think God doesn't see you? And you believe him? And what do I want then? You be a manager? A director? A CEO? An officer? Without discrepancies? You are given a task to do. You wouldn't do it. You spend your time sleeping in the church. Not doing your job. Not doing your exams. And you want to have first class? And you bring the church as a cover of your own living? Where is your responsibility? Why do you come to the church and sleep in the church as a wife, to make the pastor happy? But at home you have no time to spend with your spouse? Your husband? To cook? To make a meal? For your children? When you sleep in the church as a woman? Why? And you want God to make you the head and not the tail? You don't care for your family? And the little opportunity you have to look after them? Nothing And you ask God to give you billions? If you are not faithful to your family, without anything you have? Forget about billions. God knows what attitude you have. Like Christians. You earn about 5 or 10 of your currency. That's what you earn. You can't give to God's work. You say lord multiply me with millions. He will never do that. He won't. He won't. No matter what you say. The same reason you will give, when it's increases in your hands. You want to have the best equipment in the church. The best environment. The loving musical equipment. Your money will be this and that. But you can't point anything to it. You want to enjoy a good transmission of the messages to your hearing. But you forget it's at a cost to make those things physically working. It doesn't work, you want God to lift you up and make you the head. It won't happen. Don't waste your time. It won't happen. God demands in us the spirit of faithfulness. Towards God and towards man. That's why Pastor Paul didn't waste his time to recount to others. But to people in the church who were faithful. So that people will know that.

Why is that sister doing so well? Why is that brother doing so well? Why is there so much grace upon the earth? Why is God anointing moving so faithfully? Why is that brother having more? I told you he's drinking every year. Things are going well for him.

It's a mark of faithfulness. It's a mark of faithfulness. Faithfulness has an effect and it's a very strong one. Bring peace and tranquilly. Bring the presence of God. Even if there are

people around. God wants us to live a life that is faithful. Towards him and towards man. Paul said i have a clear conscience towards God and towards man. It's a requirement for a steward to find faithfulness. They demand it. You're not selling a little thing. Who? Somebody gives you a little amount of money. To buy something. You can't bring back the change and leave the person to make the decision to say, take it. I give it to you. Have it back. You take it off without any receipt. Without giving back the result of that. You think God will put into your hand and give you a big amount of money. You will lose. You will lose in the bank. You will lose. You will lose an opportunity when opportunity comes to you. In positions. You will sell yourself as a martyr. Because greed makes none... That greed, that covetousness, that entitlement spirit, will go destroying people and destroying you. And God knows if he raises you up, he will destroy you. The one he loves. He will leave you where you are. You can be in the church for 50 years, 100 years, No movements. He will keep you where you are, so you don't go to hell. He knows that if he gives you an extra opportunity. You won't be faithful. You won't rise beyond that wall. You will make excuses. You won't be faithful. In that high as you can make it in the little way. So, if today you want to lift yourself up and position yourself in greatness. Become faithful towards God and men. In the little ways. Where you work. Be faithful. In the journey. Be faithful. Let greed and covetousness not destroy you. Be faithful in the paths of time, Paths of men, Paths of opportunity, Paths of property, Paths of material. Whatever he has given to you. Respect it. Whatever material that has given to you to care for, even in the place of work, respect it, It's is not for self-use, for your purpose, for the business. So, when God finds you faithful. If you are not taking care of that thing in faithfulness. God will take you out and position you where you ought to be. There is always a learning curve in our life. God is a God that processes people. God is going to take us through a process. By that process he matured us. So, when we come to a place of greatness, we will remember it is a journey, that brought us there. I want to be a manager. As an ordinary staff you can't function well, you want to be a manager, you want to be a supervisor, you want to be a foreman. Yet you are not even loyal. You are not even submissive. You are not even diligent. You are not even accountable. You want God to lift you up? You will destroy people there. You will destroy material. You will destroy money. You will destroy the business. You will destroy the marriage. You will destroy husband, wife and children. So let God build you, and mature you, through his Word. Look at these people of faithfulness, I will Begin to close from there.

A man called **Tychicus**, in **Colossians 4**, **7 to 8**, **Ephesians 6**, **12-22**. A Beloved brother, a faithful minister, a fellow servant of God, For Paul to articulate that this brother is faithful. He was faithful. For his name in the written text, a faithful brother. Can you have called a faithful brother, or a busy body. You know some people are busy bodies in the church. He was a faithful brother, a faithful minister.

Another one, Epaphras, Colossians 1, 7. A dear fellow and faithful minister.

Another one, **Onesimus**, a faithful and beloved brother, **Colossians 4, 9**. Paul agreed this man was faithful. In other words, whatever you commit unto he or her, they are sure they will deliver. They are sure they will deliver. They will not go and change the text and change the script to suit their personal life. They will not go and change the description. That's what we do. You know what killed King Elisha's servant, his master told him, I don't want that from that man. He went behind the master and told the man, my master had a rethink it, He says you give it to me because he has seen this man. The leprosy of that man never fell upon him. The man had been healed. And God said, I don't need anything from you. Go and be whole. His servant, because of facelessness and greed and covetousness, he went behind the servant and told him, my master has changed his mind. He says you give him the gift. The leprosy that left the man who was killed came upon him and medically, it came upon him, as he went behind the scene to do something that is unscriptural. That's why I'm calling them faithful. Let me tell you about the musketeers. In God, if you don't stand up faithful in the law, 1 Corinthians 4, 17. Talking about who? Timothy. You will find faith. It's in the scriptures.

And then again, **Lydia**, a beloved and faithful woman in the law. **Acts 16, 14-16**. She was found by God as faithful. Faithful. It's in the scriptures. And then again, **Silvanus**, a faithful brother. **1 Peter 5, verse 12.** It's in the scriptures. Faithful. Even God himself is a faithful

God. He is so faithful. **1 Corinthians 1, verse 9**. God is faithful. God is faithful to his promises. If God is our father, let him repudiate his kind. Be a faithful man in self-negotiation. Not going to go about extorting God's people. Extorting them. With craft. Be faithful to your God. Feed them with knowledge and understanding. Not adulterations. Not to extort them. Tell the truth. Jesus was faithful in his team worship. The Bible says in Hebrews 3,1-2. He was faithful unto God.

Moses was found faithful in his team worship. Hebrews 3, 3-5. God said he was found faithful. Moses. That man who led a mobile church. Meek and humble. Faithful. Faithful. Abraham was found faithful in his team worship. That was Galatians 3, 8-9. Abraham was found faithful in his team worship. God found him faithful. If he is our father like I said last week, I'm going to preach to him. He was found faithful. Don't be crafty and cunning. To your God, I want to walk into fame, fake it to make it, you lie your way through it, I won't go through it. I want to honour you, I'm blessed, not the God I know of the body. I said devil is pursuing them, somebody doesn't like them, why do I take their life? There's no devil or demon in you.

Look inward and do research. And look inward, you will find out what you did. And tell the people of God the truth. So, they can pray for you, God will heal you and deliver you.

Daniel was faithful, Apostle Paul was found faithful too. And you can look through that scripture and see how people serve the Lord faithfully. Towards God, towards men. A

society needs faithful leaders who have the office and serve the people. Our community needs faithful people. The church of Christ needs faithful servant of God and faithful team to let the kingdom advance and the enemy come and be. This God of our kingdom requires faithfulness in him. Let it be the one who is faithful. To let God's work prevail in every circumstance. To let God be glorified in every situation. What I always require from you and I every single day as a minister of the gospel is my faithfulness on the duty post. So, I need to be faithful on that purpose, on the duty post that he has called me. When you have a struggle, a call, you do not go out and check. All God needs from you is not the noise making, his faithfulness on the duty post. Don't create what you cannot handle. Don't create a programme you know you cannot handle. Don't create an atmosphere you cannot handle. I am not looking for enemies to make it happen and say God did it. You know God didn't do it. You are doing it by yourself in flesh. Just do as you are led by the Holy Spirit of God. Do as you are always led by God. Jesus never did anything that was going to let you do this. To fast, to pray, to move about, it is the God. By his will. Go and honour his will. You want to defend any mission that God commissioned to defend. Any vision that God is there, you go and honour it. Don't make

controversy. God loves us, he cares about us a lot. This morning, this month of Revelation, this week of Revelation week, be led by the Holy Spirit.

Live the life of faithfulness. If you arrive at the wall and you have to sign in, you arrive 9 o'clock don't write 8 o'clock, Don't follow multitude to do the wrong thing. When the consequence comes, the wrongdoers have been intercepted. Work in the police station, disburse money to people. Don't steal. Don't amass wealth of people. They are public servants, and they lead people, serve people. We are required to serve people. Every gift is to serve. Every opportunity is to serve. Every creativity is to serve people. If you create a specialisation in medicine to help people's lives, it's to serve people. You have to buy food to serve people. Grow out of selfishness, grow out of entitlement, grow out of accumulation. You see, this life, I'm going to give you an example. They were this man in the Bible was very rich.

He got to Jesus and said, what can I do to inherit the kingdom of God? ...Matured us, so when we come to a place of greatness, we would remember it's a journey that brought us there. I want to be a manager. Even as an ordinary staff, you can't function well, you want to be a manager. You want to be a supervisor, you want to be a foreman, yet you're not even a loyal, you're not even submissive, you're not even diligent, you're not even accountable and you want God to lift you, you will destroy people there, you will destroy material, you will destroy money, you will destroy the business, you will destroy the

marriage, you will destroy husband, you will destroy wife, you will destroy children. So let God build you, and mature you, to his word.

There are these people of faithfulness, I will begin to close from there. A man called Tychicus in **Colossians 4, 7-8, Ephesians 6, 22-23,** wrote about him, he said, A beloved brother, a faithful minister, a fellow servant to the Lord, for poor to act good and faithful, he was faithful. For his name to be written there as a faithful brother.

Can you call him a faithful brother, or a busy brother? He was a faithful brother, a faithful minister. Another one, Epaphras, Colossians 1-7, a dear fellow and faithful minister. Another one, Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, Colossians 9-4. This person acted, so faithful that whatever was committed into his or her hand, be assured they will deliver. Be assured they will deliver they will not go and change the text and change the script, to suit their personal life. They will not go and change the description. That's what some will do. You know how King Elisha suffered? His master told him, I don't want data from that man. He went behind the master and told the man, My master says you give it to me because he has seen this man. The leprosy of that man never fell upon him. A man had been healed and God said, I don't need anything from you, go and be whole. He said that because of facelessness and greed and covetousness. He went behind the master and told him, my master has changed his mind. He says you give him the gift. The leprosy

that left the man came upon him. And many tell me, you want to go behind the scenes and do somethings that was unscriptural. And you want God to reposition you? That's not what I'm talking about, let me be faithful. Let me be more scriptural. In God, a beloved son and faithful in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 4.17. Talking about who? Timothy. You have found faith. Isn't it scriptural? And then again, Lydia, a beloved and faithful woman in the Lord. Acts 16.14-16. You have found what? Faith. Isn't it scriptural? And then again, Silvanus, a faithful brother. **Ephesians 5 verse 12.** Isn't it scriptural? Faith. Even God himself is a faithful God. Initial faithfulness. 1 Corinthians 1.9. God is faithful. If you turn to the Torah, it says God is faithful to his promises. If God is our father, that's when the produce is coming. Being faithful means you serve the gospel. Not going to go about extorting the gospel. Extorting them. Be faithful to your core. Fill them with knowledge and understanding. Not to abduct Christians. Not to extort them. Tell the truth. Jesus, in humanity, was faithful in his worship. The Bible says in **Hebrews 3.1-2.** He was faithful to God. Moses was found faithful in his stewardship. Hebrews 3.3-5. The Bible says he was found faithful. Moses, That man who led a mobile church. Meek and humble, Faithful. Faithful Abraham was found faithful in his stewardship **Galatians 3.8-9.** Abraham was found faithful in his stewardship. God found him faithful. Go look on his feet. If he's our father like I said last week, I'm appreciative. He was found faithful. Don't be crafty and cunning. Towards God and towards men, Be honest. He's back to somebody else for being faithful. Let God lift you up after a while. Then I want you to work it yourself. Fake it to make it. You lie your way through it, And you want God to honour you and bless you. Not the God I know of the Bible.

Some say, the devil is pursuing them. Somebody doesn't like them. One demon is taking their life. There's no devil or demon in you. Look inward and do your research. And do inward search. You will find out what it is. And tell the people of God the truth. So, they can pray for you. God will heal you and deliver you. Daniel was faithful. Daniel 6 verse 4. And apostle Paul was found faithful too. And you can look through the entire scripture and see how people serve the Lord faithfully. Towards God, towards men. A society needs faithful leaders. Who have the office and serve the people. Our community needs faithful people. The church of Christ needs faithful servant of God and faithful team to let the kingdom advance and the enemy come and be. This gospel of a kingdom requires faithfulness in it. Let's be the one who is faithful. To let God's word prevail in every circumstance. To let our God be glorified in every situation. Let's have God's faith in it, that God is going to be able to make us shine in His terms. In His own terms. In His own plan of goodness. There are many faithful ones in the Bible. I just mentioned a few. Who serve God faithfully. Who obey God's word faithfully. It's relevant when you find yourself. All God will always require from you and I every single day as a minister of the gospel is my faithfulness on the duty post.

That is being faithful on that purpose on the duty post that He has called you. When you know God has called you, you don't have to struggle and call you as God's own child. All God needs from you is not the noise making. It's faithfulness on the duty post. Don't create what you cannot handle. Don't create a problem you know you can't handle. Don't create an atmosphere you cannot handle. I'm not looking for enemies to make it happen. I say God did it. You know God didn't do it. You are doing it by yourself. In flesh. Just do as you are led by the Holy Spirit of God. Do as you are always led by God. Jesus never did anything that was not to do. To fast, to pray, to move around. He led the God. By His word. God will honour His word. He will defend any mission that God commissioned to defend. Any vision that God is there, He will make a vision for you. If you go in there, don't force people to make controversies. God loves us. He cares about us a lot. He wants us to see that achievement. The testimony. This month of Revelation. This week of Revelation week. Be led by the Holy Spirit. Live the life of faithfulness. If you arrive at the wall, and you have to sign in. You arrive at my door. I am there by your door. Don't come back in. Don't follow multitude to do evil. To do the wrong thing. When the consequence comes, you want God to intervene and interfere. Work in a place where you have to disburse money to people. Don't steal. Don't amass wealth of people. They are public servants. They lead people. Serve people. We are required to serve people. Every gift is to serve. Every opportunity is to serve. All we do is remind people to serve. Every creativity is to

serve people. If you create a specialisation in medicine to help people's lives, it's to serve people. You don't have to buy food. It's to serve people. Grow out of selfishness. Grow out of entitlement. Grow out of accumulation.

This life. It's like a vapour, we may have it today and do not have it tomorrow. We have it today. The man in the Bible was very rich. He went to Jesus and said, what can I do to help the kingdom of God? Christ told him, give all you have to the poor. And come and follow me. Because the money had him, not God.

He was very sad. But he died that night and left everything behind. That which I find accumulates. That which you are not trying to use to serve people. God gave you a voice to serve humanity. To serve his church. Don't listen. God gave you a brain to be creative. To serve the church. To serve humanity. You are hiding it. Don't believe in it. God gave you a brain to go to school. You have talent. You hide it. But you have to point all the wrong things around in the church. In society. You have to point out the wrong thing in your family. You can point all of them out accurately. But you can't wake up to serve, those things pointed out to fight to resolve them. You don't do that. You have to point out the evils. But you can't resolve anything. Is that what you do? That's what I call to do as a God child.

Every child has got to be a problem solver. Find somewhere, fulfil your purpose in Christ and serve it. And remain faithful in that service. Whether you are thanks or not. Serve! I'll

stop you from thanking. Serve! Let God say thank you my daughter. It doesn't matter who says thank you. It doesn't matter. Just be fixed as a servant of God. If people don't tell you thank you. Serve! Serve! God knows how to reward his own. Whatever you do for a living. In the church or outside the church. Serve! Have a heart of serving. And do it through love. Do it through love. Otherwise it will be a burden. Do it through love. You will see peace, tranquilly in you.

Let it be written in our life. Brother A's, Sister A's. In all our dedication to the gospel. It is about being faithful. Toward God and toward men. In God's faithfulness. God resides in faith with God. Let's do like wise.
